


LIONS ROAR

Rodeo performances will be held five nights, with the first performance on August 2nd and running through Saturday, August 6th.


Cowboys and cowgirls from a wide area will be competing for some \$5000.00 in prize money plus many special awards.

New Stock Law

The Texas Department of Pub. lic Safety has reminded Texas cattle owners that a new law went into effect July 1 aimed at controlling livestock on designated US and state highways.

The new law makes it illegal for a person knowingly to permit his domestic livestock to roam at large and unattended on state and federal highways. It applies regardless of whether or not the highway right of-way is fenced. Maximum fine for such violation is \$200, and each day the violation occurs may be considered a separate offense.

Farm to market roads are excepted from the law. The new law also gives law enforcement officers the authority to have such livestock picked up, when unable to locate the owner, and turned over to the sheriff or constable in the county.

The law does not prohibit the driving or herding of livestock across or along highways. It gives peace officers the authority to enforce provisions of the act without a warrant.

Col. Homer Garrison, Jr., director of the Texas Department of Public Safety, said state patrolmen will enforce provisions of the law in an effort to reduce the traffic hazard caused by animals on designated state and US highways. He said that during the year 1959 a total of 1406 rural traffic accidents occurred in Texas Service. We repair anything electri- involving animals of all types. In cal.
