## Tax Election

An election will be held on Dec. 30 to reduce the tax rate in the enlarged Clarendon College district from 85¢ per \$100 valuation to 60¢. The only polling place will be at the Canteen in Clarendon, since it was not found legal to have only two or three polling places, and it was necessary to either have only one or use all eleven.

Absentee voting began Dec. 10 and ends at 5 p. m. on Dec. 24. Voters may vote any time between 8 a. m. and 5 p. m. at the College Administration Building.

Those eligible to vote are all qualified voters of Donley County who have property rendered at the Donley County Tax Office.

## LIONS ROAR

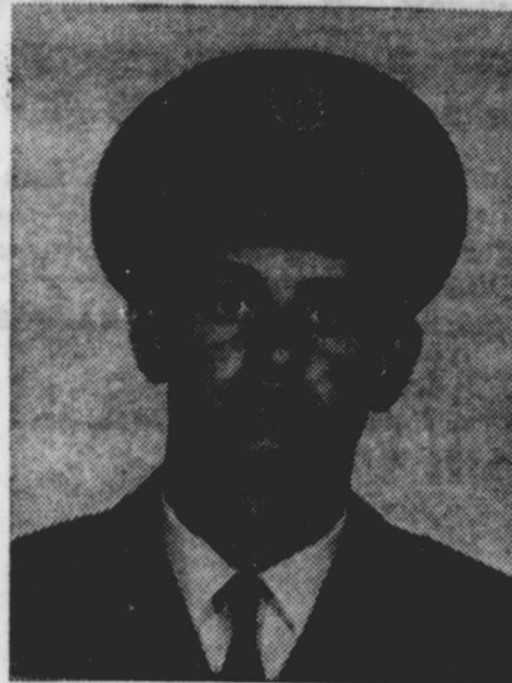
Attendance was some better at last week's meeting. The program was a film shown by Dan Nutter, Librarian at Clarendon College. He was assisted by Richard Shaw.

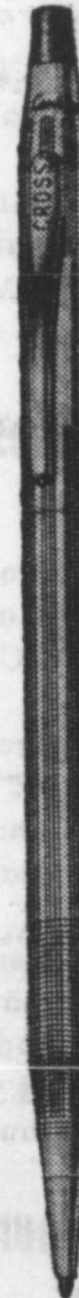

### Notice to Farmers

It has been called to the attention of the local law enforcement agencies that some of the cotton trailers are not complying with the law, in that they are not properly registered and do not carry with them proper lighting and reflectors

1 Cotton trailers in excess of 4,000 pounds (loaded) but not in excess of 15,000 pounds and used solely to transport their own seasonally harvested agricultural products and livestock from the place of production to the place of process, market or storage thereof, may operate such trailers temporarily upon the highways without the payment of the registration fees as prescribed by law, providing that the owner of such farm trailers secure, for a fee of \$5 00 for each year or a portion thereof, a registration plate from the State Highway Department, through the Donley County Tax Collector.

2 Trailers under 4,000 pounds (loaded) may move temporarily on the highway and not be required to register and pay the \$5 00 fee.

3. The rear most trailer must have a burning taillight at any hour between one half hour after sunset and one half hour before sunrise, and if the stoplight on the vehicle pulling the trailer is obstructed by the trailer, a stop light must be displayed on the rear of the trailer.

#### 1966 Cotton Program

Any cotton producer in the county may come by the County Office and enter his name on a register indicating his interest in selling or leasing cotton allotments. This information will be made available to anyone interested in this phase of the program and will remain on the counter as public information. Dec. 31, 1965 is the last date a producer may file an application for transfer of a cotton allotment either by sale or lease. A Soil Bank farm will be eligible to sell or lease a cotton allotment but this will reduce the soil bank payment rate.
