in the Cotton Referendum have approved marketing quotas for the 1968 crop of cotton. The results showed 230 voting yes and 22 voting no The vote also carried nationally.

Approval of the quotas by cotton growers mean that quotas with penalties on excess cotton much will be in effect for the 1968 crop and price support and diversion paymente, in addition to loans, will be available to growers who sigh up and then carry out the provisions of the cotton program. The program signup will be held early next year
