Proposed Public School Changes

Many people in Texas are quite shaken up by the drastic changes proposed by the Governor's Committee on Public School Education. The worst change is that of making each school have a minimum of 2,600 students, or else a county-wide school district.

No doubt the members of this committee mean well, but they are all from cities, and bave no idea of rural problems or of the fatal impact on small towns of the loss of their schools.

It is claimed that students would benefit from a wider variety of subjects offered in larger schools, but any such possible benefit is much more than offset by Phone 856-3471, 856-3022 the disadvantages of having long bus rides, of a less personal relationship between teacher and pupil, of decreased opportunities for activities and leadership, and less time to spend at home

Certainly Hedley High School can point to a gratifying number of graduates who have made ex cellent records after their student days here They are graduates of whom any school could be proud, and the quality of their instruction has obviously not been inferior






