## Tom Christain Announces For State Representative

State Rep. Tom Christain of Claude announced his candidacy for re-election to the Texas House of Representatives Thursday morning during a press conference in Amarillo.

Christain represented Armstrong, Briscoe, Carson, Collingsworth, Donley and Randall Counties during the 61st Legislature and was instrumental in the passing of several pieces of legislation during his freshman year in the House

"Serving as a State Representative from the 75th District has been a privilege," Christain said "I am grateful to the voters of the district for the opportunity to serve in this capacity."

The farmer rancher said "being a member of the Texas Legislature is an extremely challenging experience"

"A member can take pride in some of the accomplishments of the Legislature but at the same time become disheartened over some of the legislation which passes," he said

Christain cited as an example that "State spending increased 10 times faster than the population in the 1960s."

"Had it not been for the strong efforts of those of us who urge economy in governmental operations the spending would have been still worse," he said.

The legislator served on the Criminal-Jurisprudence, Education Juvenile Crime, Public Land and Buildings and Livestock committees and has an interim committee appointment on State Franchises.

"I am pleased that we were able to establish a separate Board of Regents for West Texas State University," the 1955 graduate of WTSU said. "I think the university will now have people all over the state working in its behalf"

Christain served in the United States Navy before graduating from college, then taught school at Boys Ranch and Canadian. He currently farms and ranches near Claude.

He is married to the former Anne Thomas and has three children.

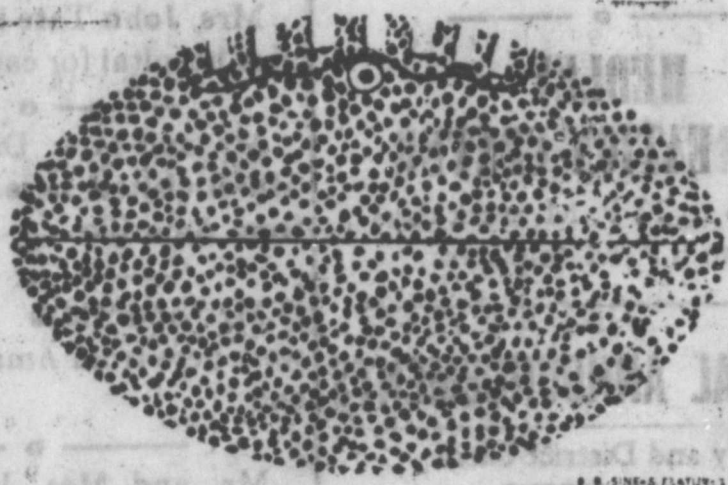

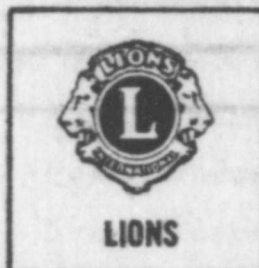

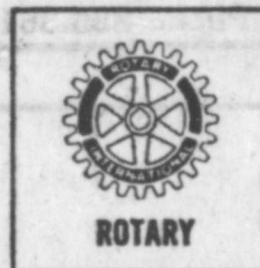
