

## Legal Notice

In accordance with Chapter 1 Title 121 of the Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, all owners of any livestock shall within six months after August 30, 1971, have his mark and brand for such stock recorded in the office of the county clerk of the county in which the livestock are located The mark or brand shall be recorded whether the mark or brand has been previously recorded or not.

After the expiration of sx months from August 30, 1971 all records of marks and brands now in existence in the county shall no longer be in force or effect, and after the expiration of six months only the records made after August 30, 1971, shall be examined or considered in recording marks and bran s in the county.

All marks and brands registered under the provisions of this Act shall be re-registered every 10 years.

The location of the mark or brand must be designated. Your County Clerk has posted a diagram on the bulletin board in the courthouse showing various parts of animal that may show mark or brand.






