Austit-Comptroller Pob Bul lock says bis office ban ibwitteb sales tax procedures on agricultural exemptions to make them all easy to read as a mail-order cata-

The new procedures will be ef feetive about July 15, he said

The Comptroller said he pro wadures clarify the fact that the following items are exempt from the sales tax: expendable supplies such as band tools baling wire. b nders twine, hardware tires and Pibricants 'or farm mach nery: fantes, pens, gates, cattle guarde and chutes; and structures that can be considered a piece of equip ment, such as sutomated laying houses and fe rowing hou es However, most farm tuil i ge, such as berns, garages, warehouses and family dwellings, are taxable, be said

Any farmer or rancher seeking an exemption must have ah exemption certificate on file with the retailer at the time of purchase.

The Comptroller said that persons needing more information about the new procedu es may catt the Comptroller's Office tollfree at 1 800-292 9687.




