

LABEL PACKAGES:

Date and identify freezer packages so 1) you don't

accumulate a lot of mysterious shapes and 2) you'll be able to pick out foods that have been in the freezer longest.

ALLOW SPACE FOR EXPANSION:

Food in containers or jars shouldn't come up to more than 1/2 inch from the top; leave at least 1 inch for a quart of liquid.




