Children from families whom income meets those indicated wa the attached charts are eligible by, 856-3661. for free meals In, addition, familize not meeting those crireria but with other unusual expenses Eligibility Income Scale due to unusually high medical expanass shelter costs in excess of 30% of income, special education expenses due to the mental or physical condition of a child, and disaster casualty losses are urged to apply

Application forms will be given to students when they enroll in chases Additional copies are available at the principal's officet The information provided on the application is confidential and will be used only for the purpose of determining elipibility Applications may be submitted at any time during the year.

In certain cashe foster children are also eligible for these benefits, If a family has foster children living with them and wish to apply for free meals you should contact the school.
