## Joint School and City Election

Sharon Wheatly reports that students of the 7th, 9th, and 11th grades were recently given scholastic tests from the Educational Development Service.

They rated vocational subjects as their favorites, and half the students wished to go into sports or social services.

The scores showed that 85% of the students read on or above their grade level and 92% should be able to do the math for their grade or higher, indicating that Hedley students compared very favorably to other students in the nation.

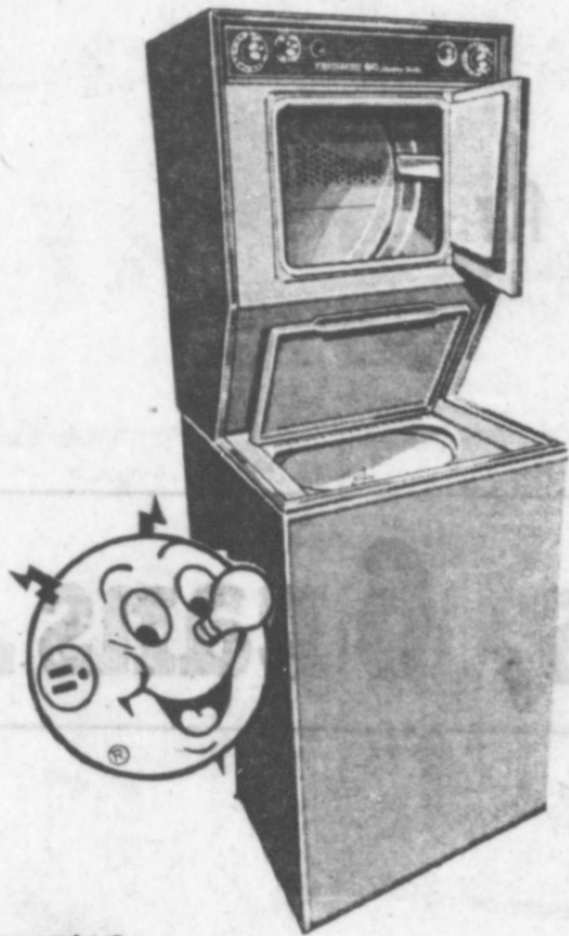

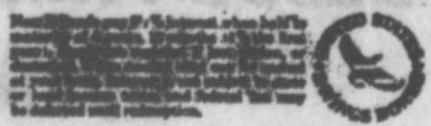
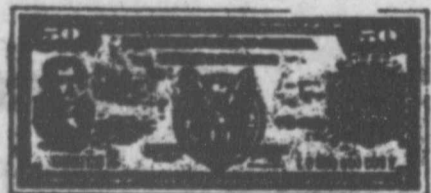
