Attendance Rules Changed

A new law passed by the 71st Texas Legislature will change attendance
rules in school districts throughout the state. Provisions of the law require that a student be in
attendance at least eighty (80) days attendance at least eighty $(80)$ days
each semester to receive credit. No each semester to receive credit. No
distinction is made about excused or unexcused absences. Parents of students will be notified
when their children are about to when their children are about to
exceed the limit and after the limit
has been exceeded. Each district will establish an attendance committee to
consider exter absences in excess of the rule limit occurs. Decisions made by this
committee can be mpealed the the Board of Trustees in each district.
