Doctor's Note After An Absence for Illness
Upon return to school, a student absent for more than 3 consecutive days clinic verifying the illness or condition that caused the student's extended absences from school.

- Medical Absences During School Day: A medical absence does not count against the student. For the student to receive a medical absence the following must be documented: student must sign in and/or our of school in the office, student must bring a note from the health care professional they student signed in and/or out of school. Therefore, the student must have been in attendance for part of the same school day in order to receive a Medical Absence. Perfect attendance awards will be presented to any student who qualifies for the award in any grade level. Students must be in attendance for the whole school day and not miss any class to receive a perfect attendance award.
Student Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures
For your child's safety, students need tobe dropped off and picked up from the following location:
- All students must be dropped off and picked up in the back parking lot only.
- Tutorials will be dismissed at $3: 30$ in the back parking lot
- Bus pick up area will now be located on Edward's Street across from Lopez Bakery

Report cards with each student's grades or performa are issued to parents at least once every nine 9 weeks. At the end of the first four weeks of a grading period, parents will be given a written progress report if their child's performance in any core subject is near or below 75 , or is below the expected level of performance. If the student receives a grade lower than 70 in any class or subject at the end of a grading period, the parent will be requested to schedule a conference with the teacher of that class or subject.

## Cafeteria Services
