Parmer SWCD To Sponsor Contests

Each year at this time, the Parmer County Soil and Water Conservation District sponsors a coloring, poster and essay contest for the school children in Parmer County. The Parmer County S.W.C.D. sponsors these contests each year to encourage soil and water conservation and help the children become aware of such concerns at a young age while making it fun and rewarding for them.

Kindergarten through second grades will have a coloring contest. The entries will be judged from each school. There will be a first, second and third place winner from each grade in each school and they will receive ribbons. The top entries will then be judged county-wide. The first, second and third place county winners will receive trophies.

Third grade through sixth grades will have a poster contest. The posters will be on a 22"x14" poster board. The themes for this year are "Harmony: People and Places" and "Backyard Stewardship." The "Harmony: People and Places" theme stresses the relationship between people and their environment.

The "Backyard Stewardship" theme emphasizes how successful soil and water conservation is accomplished by individuals, farmers and ranchers, working together to provide a healthy environment.

Seventh grade through twelfth grades will have an essay contest. The essay contest will be "Soil and Water Conservation." This title includes, but is not limited to, the following general concept: the soil and water resources of

this nation are vital for providing us with the necessities of food and shelter.

The entries will be judged in two categories per school. Seventh and eighth grades will be category one and ninth through twelfth grades will be category two. Each category will have a first, second and third place winner and they will receive ribbons. The top entries will then be judged county-wide with the first, second, third and fourth place winners receiving monetary awards.

The first place winner of the poster and essay contest will be sent to a regional contest in Temple. There is not a regional contest for the coloring contest. There is an open contest and does not in any way jeopardize Texas University Interscholastic League eligibility.

All entries must be received on or before Friday, January 17, 1997.

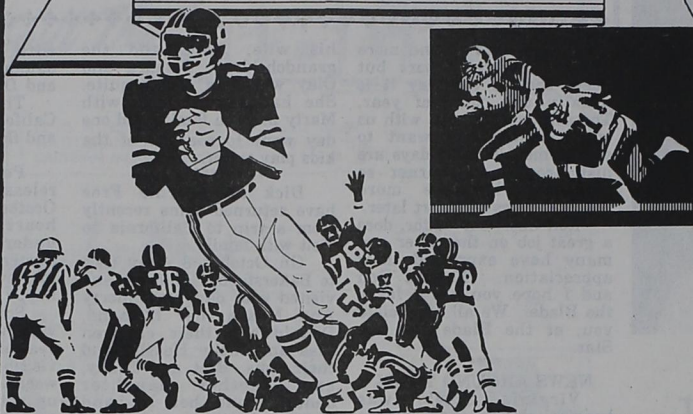

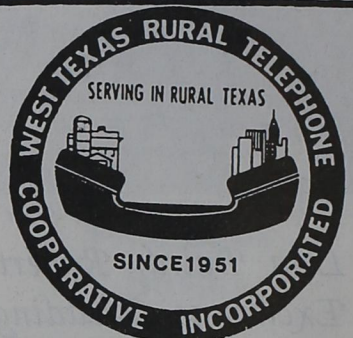
