## Machines to Chart Faults In Speech

STATE COLLEGE, Pa.—Dr. Herbert Koepf-Baker, head of Pennsylvania State College speech clinic, has invented a machine designed to record accurately "the mechanism of speech."

The device, which Dr. Koepf-Baker calls an "electrical phonocinesigraph," or "sound-movement-writer," is capable of tracing graphically the spasms of stutters and stammerers and the faulty tongue movements of lispers, and is said by the inventor to be "very useful in aiding deaf mutes in acquiring speech."

Dr. Koepf-Baker said the machine can also be used to "explore the articulatory vagaries of racial groups. For instance, he said, it will show why the Japanese find "L" elusive and over-stresses "S"; how the French produce their characteristic "R," and why the Celts' speech is "fuzzy" rather than clipped, like the Englishman's.

Explaining that other instruments for recording speech movements antedate his invention, Dr. Koepf-Baker said they were all cumbersome and inaccurate, and Peck of Dallas, formerly of Breckenridge.
