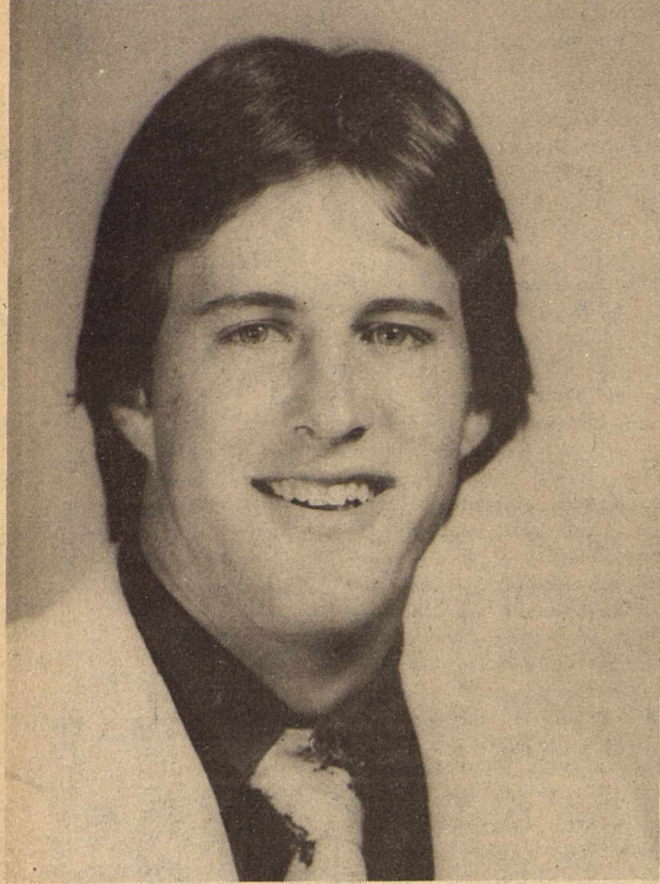

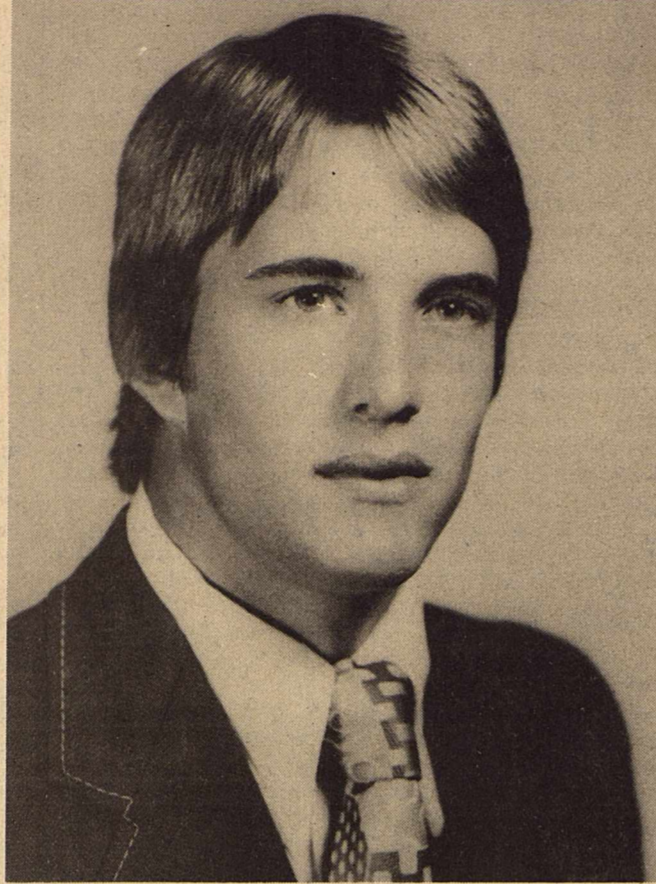

Lumber Company Compiles History Of 75 Years

Just released is a booklet that tells you, among other things, what Mr. Galbraith telegraphed about Mr. Foxworth in 1901.

The booklet is entitled "The 75th Year" and is a condensed history of the Foxworth-Galbraith Lumber Company. Reproductions of interesting old photographs make up about half of the 20 pages of easy-reading text. Copies are available at the local Foxworth-Galbraith Building Materials Center.

Ted McClung, manager of the local Foxworth-Galbraith Building Materials Center, comments, "very few American businesses reach 75 years of age and the whole story of Foxworth-Galbraith strikes me sort of like a good lesson in the free enterprise system". McClung points out, "a part of this success story has happened right here in Sonora because our local center is now forty years old.

Last of the three original founders died in 1960 and the Company is now managed by second and third generation Foxworths and Galbraiths. "One of the things the booklet points out" says McClung, "is the importance of the local manager and employees to the successful operation of the Company. From the very start, we have built our business by trying to better serve customers".

Foxworth-Galbraith now operates 51 Building Materials Centers in Texas, New Mexico, Arizona, and California. Company headquarters are in Dallas with division offices in Phoenix, Arizona, and district offices in Sherman and San Angelo, Texas. Approximately 450 people are employed in the total operation.

"The 75th Year" booklet points out that the Company has always kept abreast of the changing times, and is today modernizing facilities and increasing merchandise selection in each community served. Special values will be featured during the balance of the year to call attention to the upcoming 75th anniversary. The booklet makes one thing abundantly clear. The folks at Foxworth-Galbraith here and at 50 other places think of themselves as "people helpers since 1901", and they have the history to back it up.

Screwworm Alert Sounded

Warm weather and rains over a big part of Texas have combined to provide ideal conditions for the most serious livestock pest in the state—the ever-menacing screwworm.

"Stockmen should be particularly alert for this flesh-eating pest at this time because infestations can build up rapidly in late spring and early summer unless all cases are reported as soon as possible," points out Clint Langford, county agent for the Texas Agricultural Extension Service.

"Regular herd checks and the treatment of all wounds is essential to keep screwworm cases at a minimum," emphasizes Langford.

Any worms found in livestock wounds should be sent to the Mission Lab, Box 969, Mission, Texas 78572. Kits for mailing the worm samples are available from the county Extension office and local livestock inspectors and veterinarians.
