## Another Edict

The latest effort by James Caesar Petrillo, boss man of the American Federation of Musicians, to win friends coming development in radio, which is frequency modula-
tion (FM). Not many people have FM receivers today. But those

through FM as well as standard outlets. Petrillo is all-powerful, and so the broadcasters capitulate
and announce that they/will not pipe any more network programs to FM. An advancement in radio has been stymied and the best programs will not be available for
better reception, all because Petrillo tried to collect another tribute.
