# Loss of Ambulance Service Very Serious Matter

(An Editorial)

The voters of Coke County were rather loud and clear in their rejection last Friday of the construction of an annex building for the courthouse. Perhaps it's just as well that the matter was voted down, and perhaps the opinion of the rank and file of our citizens is the wisest for the good of all of us.

Another matter is facing citizens of the county that probably is of much more importance to everyone.

That matter is the question of providing ambulance service for our citizens.

Gary Shaffer has announced that for reasons of economy he will quit operating his ambulance service on Jan. 15. Shaffer, like everybody else who has tried to provide ambulance service, is faced with government requirements and regulations which make the operation completely unfeasible. Like so many other areas of our lives, rating for its activities we have allowed, and are continuing to allow, government regulations to price us out of the

things we need.

County Livestock Association are expecting another successful show this year. The number of entries and the number of buyers at the auction sale continue to grow each year, and those in charge feel the success of the show are a good indication of the healthy condition of the livestock industry in Coke County.

Everyone is invited to plan to attend the show.

Show catalogs have been printed and distributed to all prospective exhibitors and buyers.

As stated above, the same holidays will apply to next week for most business firms who will take off on Monday for the New Year's holiday, since it, too, comes on Sunday.

Shaffer has a problem. His predecessors had problems. In spite of token help from the county, the operation of the ambulance service is a losing proposition. For example, Shaffer told us that an accounting for  $2\frac{1}{2}$  months showed he lost approximately \$1400 during the period. That's too much to ask of any businessman. In addition to the monetary loss, regulations make it impossible for him to have any personal freedom. In other words, if he is going to operate an ambulance service, he has to be on the job all the time.

It all boils down to the fact that we need to find a solution to this problem.

The county, the Cities of Bronte and Robert Lee and the West and East Coke County Hospital Districts all should be interested in working on the problem and should make every effort to cooperate and work out the problem.

Our conversations with Shaffer show that he is very interested in helping any way he can. A sitting down and talking session is imperative and we should get right to it.
