**ENGLAND NOTICES**

Formally Advised to Change Dealings in London—In reply to President Wilson's communication announcing his determination to eliminate General Huerta and his adherents from power in Mexico, Great Britain Saturday answered formally that her policy was strictly one of noninterference.

It was understood the other European powers had sent similar replies to that of Great Britain after exchanging views, which it was understood Washington desired.

President Wilson's note to the powers, while it stated clearly his intention to get rid of Huerta, did not, it is understood, include any outline as to how he expected to accomplish that object in case Huerta should remain deaf to persuasion.

As an official pointed out, however, "it is not difficult to forecast what would happen. Should General Huerta not voluntarily withdraw and the financial pressure and the blockade of the Mexican ports prove ineffectual, intervention must follow."

It is expected President Wilson will communicate to the powers successive steps of the proceedings as he has been doing. So far as Great Britain is concerned it is pointed out he may rely on her reply being the same in each case—namely, noninterference.

With her moral support and sympathy on the side of the United States, England remains firm also to her decision not to dispatch a warship to Mexican waters. She is assured the United States will afford her citizens and her trade interests every protection.

All this has been clearly explained to Ambassador Page on his frequent visits to Sir Edward Grey at the British foreign office.

**THE FERTILIZATION ON SOUTHERN FARMS**

Leguminous Crops Occupy Important Place on Every Farm.

**PLANTS HAVE HIGHEST VALUE**

Must Be Grown in Cotton Belt to Economically Enrich Our Cultivated Lands and to Furnish Proper Food for Live Stock.

Leguminous crops have a very important place in every safe and sane system of farming. These crops possess a characteristic which makes them of the highest value to the farmer. This is the power to utilize the free nitrogen of the soil air. When we examine the roots of luxuriantly growing leguminous plants, we find numerous nodules or tubercles on them. These tubercles are caused by certain organisms or bacteria in the soil. It now seems that there is a special form of bacteria for each legume grown, though some forms of bacteria in time learn to live on two or more legumes.

It is a matter of great importance to furnish the soil lacking the necessary organisms with a good supply of the right kind of bacteria. There are several methods of putting the necessary bacteria in the soil. A good way is of inoculating the soil to soak the seed at planting time in water in which the soil from a field where the legume has been successfully grown for a number of years has been stirred. Another excellent way of inoculating the soil is to drill in with the seed soil in which that particular legume has been grown for a number of years. Care should be taken to keep the soil out of the sunshine from the time it is taken from the field until it is worked into the soil of the next, as the rays of the sun will kill the bacteria. It is best to get the soil and apply it on a cloudy day, or late in the afternoon.

Nitrogen is the costliest element of plant food and is becoming scarcer and dearer so far as its commercial forms are concerned. This being true, a system of farming which provides a means for the collection of this valuable and costly element from the

Introduction of legumes into the farm rotation will not increase indefinitely the productivity of the soil. Liberal applications of phosphoric acid and potash must be made where the soil does not contain an abundance of these elements.

The farmer who grows leguminous crops and keep good live stock want to know whether to use the treated or untreated phosphate rock to increase the yields of his legumes and to improve his soil. The conclusions I draw from a careful study of the results obtained at several experiment stations are that on a very poor soil, acid phosphate will pay better for a few years, at any rate, even if the leguminous crops are turned under, but that on a very fertile soil raw phosphate rock will pay better, especially when used with stable manure or leguminous crops. In most cases it would seem to be advisable to use a light application of acid phosphate the first year, and sometimes for several years, until the latter gets into action.

Legumes used as winter cover crops not only transfer nitrogen from the soil to the soil, but at the same time reduce the leaching out of the plant food already present in the soil to the minimum. More humus and more nitrogen in the soil and more winter and early spring grazing are probably the greatest needs of the south. These needs can be fully satisfied by planting such crops as the vetches or the winter clovers. In discussing the subjects of legumes as a winter cover crop, Dr. Tal Butler says: "For many years to come the plowing under of crops grown as winter cover crops will be the most practical and profitable method of increasing the fertility of our soils and rapid increase is not likely to occur until this method becomes general as a frequent and constant practice."

The leguminous crops are especially rich in protein, which furnishes material for the production of lean meat, muscles, nerves, skin, blood, tendons, wool, hair, casin in milk, albumin of eggs, and so forth. This makes the legumes especially valuable for feeding farm animals in connection with fat-producing foods, such as corn and sorghum.

The German standard rations were computed from digestion experiments without reference to the comparative cost or convenience of obtaining the various feeding stuffs. There is a growing tendency to break away from the idea which has long prevailed that successful feeding must conform to the German feeding standards. Prof. W. A. Henry says: "The feeder should

**GUILD WELFARE GETS FIRST CONSIDERATION**

A Number of Resolutions on Subject Adopted at Meeting of Texas Congress of Mothers.

Fort Worth, Tex.—The conference of the Texas Congress of Mothers and Parent Teachers' Association ended Friday after adopting a number of resolutions which bore directly upon the subject of child welfare and rejecting one which the conference by a close vote decided was foreign to the general purposes of the association. The resolution, read by Mrs. Hortense Ward, would have placed the association on record as favoring the ballot for women in Texas, but by a vote of 18 to 17 this was lost.

The following subjects were covered in resolutions adopted:


Statewide safe and sane celebration of national holidays; censorship of motion picture shows and theaters; more concise birth records; the establishment of a pension system for teachers who have given twenty years to school work; a child welfare exhibit at the Texas State fair, the Texas Cotton Palace and county displays, and a building at the Texas State fair for the exhibit; means for arousing greater interest in the mothers' compensation and minimum wage act and a correction of the defects of the fifty-four-hour law; child labor and compulsory education laws; legislation for institutions for the incurably insane and a broadening of the work of the extension department of the congress.

When the resolution endorsing woman suffrage was introduced, some keen discussion promised to follow. It was the opinion of some of the champions of the cause to vote as individuals and not as a congress on the measure. To this Mrs. Ward replied that she could not see why a person favoring woman's suffrage would hesitate to firmly stand by her belief. Mrs. Ward told the conference that the best way for the mothers to secure the legislation in favor of the child was by direct methods, and that the ballot would be the weapon the woman could use with much effect. The first vote, taken by acclamation, could not be decided. The president called for a rising vote and the count showed eighteen voting on each side. The second ballot gave the opposition victory.

Mrs. Frank Buchner of Austin, who made a report on the child welfare commission bill, gave figures showing how much money was being spent for the protection of game and live stock and how little was allowed for the protection of the children, who she said, formed the strength of the state. A child welfare bureau was advocated in this connection.

Reports from the city councils of Mothers and Parent Teachers' associations was made by Mrs. James M. Young for San Antonio, Mrs. Frank Buchner for Austin, Mrs. G. F. Arnold for Houston, Mrs. Donald Hinekey for Dallas, and Mrs. George W. Steere for Fort Worth. Mrs. Charles Schueber reported on the school libraries committee and Mrs. Steere for the kindergarten committee.

**INTERNATIONAL SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON**

(By E. O. SELLERS, Director of Evening Department, The Moody Bible Institute, Chicago.)

**LESSON FOR NOVEMBER 23**

**JOSHUA THE NEW LEADER.**

**LESSON TEXT**—Joshua 1:1-5. **GOLDEN TEXT**—"Be strong and of good courage." Joshua 1:9.

"Now it came to pass" (v. 1). Things do not happen in the kingdom of God, they come to pass. This world, nations, families or individuals were not set in motion by a creator who has gone off neglectful of his creatures, nor has he left them to blind fate or inflexible law. Attention is also drawn to the time, "after the death of Moses."

The call was clear and unquestioned, for the Lord "spoke." Our highest responsibility is to that call which comes from the highest source of authority. This call came in the time of great need, Israel is without a leader. Then follow the five words of Jehovah to this newly chosen leader (v. 2) and which constitute his charge. "Moses my servant is dead, now, therefore arise." This suggests a prayerful attitude on the part of Joshua, but in no way is it to be construed that Moses was a hindrance to this forward march of the people of God. Rather, that Moses' work was completed and on the basis of his work an advance was to be made.

**Obedience to Law.**  
The conditions laid upon Joshua were: (1) Confidence due to this promise of the presence of Jehovah (v. 5). The personal pronoun "I" is used seven times in these nine verses as though God would make confidence doubly assured. But confidence alone was not enough, hence the necessity of "courage" (v. 6). Strength is due to confidence and quietness, Isa. 30:15, but courage is the active principle which is the evidence of our strength and courage. Conquest was not alone conditioned upon courage (v. 6), but also upon the sure foundation of the word and oath of Jehovah. But strength and courage are maintained by obedience to law whether it be physical, civil or spiritual, hence the words of verse 7, the possession of this land depended upon absolute obedience, inviolable adherence and observance of the law, "which Moses my servant commanded."

**Confidence and Authority.**  
But Joshua never leaves his own (v. 5), Matt. 28:20, nor does he leave man to blind fate or fortuitous circumstances. Therefore we read in verse 8 the counsel of Jehovah as to the method whereby Joshua and Israel may "prosper" (v. 7) or according to the margin "do wisely," viz., they shall meditate upon the books of the law. This verse is enough for the entire class session. The leader, be he preacher or teacher, who has any doubt about the word of God, or stands dumb before the empty tomb had better seek a new vocation for he is the apostle of a dying, disintegrating class or church and a decadent faith. The origin of man, the mystery of life, the destiny of the soul, demands the voice of confidence and authority not of uncertainty and doubt. True prosperity and wisdom are conditioned upon our taking the word of God as the man of our counsel, the light of our path, our daily meditation. The definite result of such a course is set before Joshua, and in addition he was promised the companionship (v. 9) of Jehovah every step of the way. It is interesting in this connection to remember that Joshua was associated with Moses in the first experience of war in the history of this young nation.

**Conclusion.** The greatest lesson before us at this time is that of continuity of the purposes of God. As great and important as Moses has been during his 40 years of leadership, yet he was not necessary. The instrument of divine deliverance, direction and discipline, yea, the voice of God to Israel, the receiver of their complaints and of their confessions, yet now he has been removed. What a tremendous blank he must have left. Yet Israel is to go forward, there is to be no halting in its progress. God had been training men for 40 years, one of whose faith failed not at the sight of the giants, one who had fellowship with the old and is now to face the new. We recall the words of John Wesley, inscribed upon his memorial tablet in Westminster abbey, "God furries his workmen, but carries on his work." Each individual in the long succession of leaders fills his appointed task, and as he is loyal completes that task thereby preparing the way for a new leader. The abiding principles that condition each man's success are loyalty and obedience.

The Golden Text is in substance three repeated. First, Joshua was to be strong and of good courage because of the work ahead of him (v. 6); second, he was to be strong and courageous in the observance of the law; and lastly he was to be strong and courageous in order to avoid the perils of fear and dismay which were to beset the path of advance (v. 9).

A study of the remainder of this chapter reveals not only the orderly response of the people but that the people, as well as God, also demanded of their leader that he should "be strong and of a good courage."

An 4 at Petrolia, capable of producing barrels per day was re-erected in by the Wichita Falls Gas company.

It has been raised to \$100,000 by the Grayson county association, which will exhibit in Sherman Nov. 15.

Contract has been let at Midland for the construction of 44 miles of macadamized roads. These highways will be built from the proceeds of a \$50,000 bond election.

The electric light plant at Quanah has changed hands and is being rebuilt at a cost of \$125,000. The new power also plans the erection of a transmission line to Chillicothe to furnish light and power for that town.

Preliminary engineering tests are being conducted across the Brazos river at Prosser for the purpose of erecting a site for the \$60,000 steel draw-bridge to be erected across the river connecting that city and Velasco. If present plans are carried out the bridge will be completed and opened to travel by the first of the year.

A delegation of the Southern commercial congress, representing 12 Southern states have selected a spot on the bluff of the north end of Cuba cut overlooking the site of the Gamma dike, and dedicated it for a bronze medal tablet with a life-size bust of the late John Tyler Morgan, United States senator from Alabama. Mr. Morgan was at one time chairman of the senate committee on interoceanic canals and was known as the father of the canal idea.

That some oil mills will take no step to comply with the ruling of the attorney general that they must relinquish the ownership of cotton gins until the validity of the law on which the ruling was based is tested through the courts has been indicated by local managers at Waxahatchie. Information obtained is to the effect that a movement has been started among the mill managers of Texas to carry the matter into the courts.

Laws for compulsory education and further limiting child labor are proposed by Dr. A. C. Ellis, who is head of the child welfare division of the state university. Dr. Ellis is preparing charts and tables for exhibition over the state to prove that compulsory education is best for the children and best for the state. Texas already has laws for the benefit of children workers, but Dr. Ellis declares there is room for improvement and he expects to arouse the public to the actual needs and in this way assure legislation.

One hundred or more persons, most of whom were women, were hurt, eight seriously, when the bleachers on DePaul university athletic field at Green Castle, Ind., collapsed just before a football game. It was estimated that more than 700 men and women were on the bleachers when they went down. The swaying of the crowd in cheering the DePaul team as it came on the field is believed to have been the immediate cause of the collapse.

The good road bonds voted at Mexico in the sum of \$125,000 over a year ago have been disposed of and a complete survey of the proposed roads made. It is expected that actual work will begin at once.

Parties recently engaged in the work of logging the Dallas-to-the-Gulf highway have completed their task. The road is 247 miles long and runs the entire way on a ridge or plateau and includes some beautiful scenic sections.

An election will be held at Austin soon to determine the issuance of \$125,000 in numerical bonds. Of this amount \$50,000 will be used for a market house, \$50,000 for an abattoir, and \$25,000 for a fire alarm system.

Taxable valuations for Houston are over \$100,000,000, leading all other Texas cities. The taxable valuation of Harris county is \$29,673,000, and also this is the highest taxation ever enumerated by any county of this state.  
A few more than 701,000 people passed through the gates at the state fair at Dallas from Oct. 18 to No. 2. This is about 80,000 less than last year. Bad weather is given as the cause.  
An elaborate program has been planned for the second annual "Turkey Trot" which will be conducted in Cicero Nov. 18 to 21. More than 20,000 "nobblers" will participate in the big parade, which will be headed by the governor and other state officials.
