This fall vegetable can be used in many ways for deliclous dishes for your family. <br> First, select a pumpkin which is heavy for its size. Here's the recipe for the Pumpkin Souffle: <br> $21 / 2$ cups mashed pumpkin, <br> canned or cooked <br> $1 / 4$ cup melted butter or margarine <br> $1 / 2$ teaspoon salt <br> 3 tablespoons $1 / 2$ cup hot milk <br> 3 eggs, beaten separately <br> 1 teaspoon grated lemion rind <br> $1 / 2$ cup raisins or coconut <br> Add butter, salt, sugar, milk <br> and beaten egg yolks to mashed pumpkin. Beat until fluffy. Beat egg whites until stiff; fold in rind, ralsins or coconut to pumpkin mixture. Put into ungreased casserole and bake at 350 degrees F. 1 hour or unt1l lightly brown. Serves six to eight. <br> Freezing pumpkin now for | use later is very easy. Simply wash, and cut the pumpkin into small pleces. Remove the seeds and peel. Then cook in a small amount of bolling water, or in a pressure cooker or sauce pan, or in an oven. <br> mash the pumpkin is tender mash the pulp or put it through containing the pumpkin over chopped ice, and strir the pumpkin occasionally for cooling. Then package in freezer jars, or plastic freezer containers.
