NEW PROJECT - HOUSTON PARTIES PROMOTERS.

Line of Road to be Built From Robert Lee to Brady-Surveyors Ready for Work.

T. J. Webb, whose ranch is on the Colorado river about twentyfive miles above Ballinger, was in Ballinger Friday, and is our authority for a railroad story that may be brought to the attention of the people in the near future. Mr. Webb told the writer that surveyors were in the Robert Lee and Bronte country, and would probably be in Ballinger in a few days. He said he learned through one of the surveyors that Houston parties were promoting a line of road to be built from Robert Lee to Brady, and that he traveled on the train from San Angelo to Bronte with one of the surveyors and was informed by the surveyor that his business was to look out a route for a road leading out from Bronte down the Colorado river on the north side to Ballinger and from Ballinger to Brady. Further than this no statement was made by




