BRADY POST OFFICE

GIVEN AN IMPORTANT DISTINCTION.

Designated Supply Station for Forty-Two Postoffices in This Territory.

Notice has been received by Postmaster A. B. Reagan that the Brady office had been designated by the Postmaster General as the supply station for all third and fourth class post offices in the counties of McCulloch (except Stacy and Doole), Menard, Mason, Kimble (except Noxville), and post offices at Ruth, Eden, Welview, Pasche and Lightner, in Concho county. These offices are sixteen in McCulloch county, five in Menard county, nine in Mason county, seven in Kimble county and five in Concho county.

These supplies have heretofore been furnished from the post office department at Washington, D. C., upon requisition of the postmasters. The post offices mentioned above, however, have recently been instructed to make their requisitions on the Brady office for their supplies.

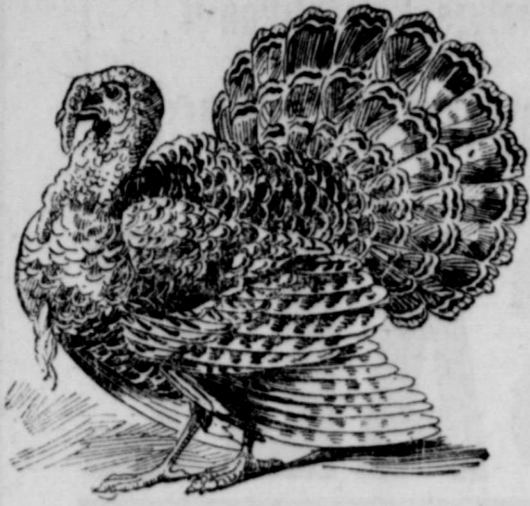
