WILL IMPROVE ROADS. Commissioner Carroll Buys New Engine and Grader
Commissioner J. M. Carroll
was in from Lohn Wednesday,
and in the course of conversa-
aion stated that he had just place
ed the order for an oil pull en-
gine and grader, which he ex-
pects to put on the roads in his
precinct immediately upon its
arrival next week. The new en-
gine develops 25 horse-power,
while the grader used will make
a 10-ft. cut. By using this grad-
er as much work can be done in
