Too commonly our school gives us our opinions ready-made.
We put too much faith in what we see in print. If public opinion,

Equality means fraternity, brotherhood, fair dealing, exclu-
sion of no one from public benefits because of race or poverty or lowly birth. It means rejection of inherited titles of nobility. It means avoidance of distinctions tending to put one man above anAer. Equality is an essential of the American Idea.

greed of profiteers and the ignorance of parents place undeveloped children in factories and mines the American IIdea of the right of all to life is gone. Against this greed the public schools stand as the best proposal of the national purpose to give all the people
