C．A．Doose and other Ballin－ er members of the Irrigation company formed some month ago，have been in this section some days this week furthering As we gain from hearsay，thes are in search of a feasible point on the Colorado river to construct a dam，and have decided on a
test survey at Codar mountain， test survey at Codar mountain，

at this point and it is estimated that a monster dam 75 feet in height will form an enormous ake and give a water supply that will irrigate the Colorado rive alley for many miles．
