**Boys Ranch to  
Benefit From 4-H  
Club Show At  
Hereford Feb. 21**

Boys Ranch at Old Tascosa is being cut in for a big share of the sales at the Rotary-sponsored 4-H Club Stock Show here on February 21.

Deaf Smith county 4-H Club Boys, in a meeting last Saturday, voted unanimously to give 3 per cent of the gross sales of their calves to Boys Ranch, according to F. G. Collier.

Several of the boys individually, Collier reports, have indicated an intention of upping that percentage.

Boys from Boys Ranch will be special guests of the Deaf Smith County 4-H Club boys in Hereford on the day of the show. Boys Ranch management is arranging in cooperation with the Hereford Rotary Club, to declare a holiday and bring every boy from the Ranch to Hereford for the show.

The Boys Ranch youngsters have also been invited to enter their stock in the show here.

"This is going to be the biggest show of its kind in the country," Henry Sears, chairman of the Rotary Club steering committee, predicted this week.

A monster parade will feature the show, according to Parade Marshal Faust Collier. Among the organizations expected to take part in the parade, in addition to the 4-H clubbers and their guests, the Boys Ranch delegation, are the Will Rogers Range Riders from Amarillo, the Deaf Smith Riders, The Clovis Mounted patrol, Hereford Boy Scouts and Campfire Girls, Cub Scouts, the Hereford High School Band, and the West Texas State College Buffalo Band.

In addition, there will be a special kid pony section, with every youngster in the area who has a pony or can get one invited to bring his mount and take part in the parade.

The Rotary Club's Barbecue committee is preparing to feed over 1,000 people at a big barbecue on the show grounds at noon. Earl Phillips is in charge of arrangements.

Club boys and the lads from boys Ranch will be honor guests. In addition, local Rotarians have extended invitations to members of Rotary clubs at Amarillo, Clovis, Canyon and Littlefield, to the Kiwanis

Club at Vega, and to the Lions Clubs at Dimmitt and Friona to attend.

A number of prominent guests are being invited. Heading the list are Governor Beauford Jester of Texas and Governor Mabry of New Mexico.

Ed McLaughlin, of Ralls, leading candidate for the next presidency of Rotary International, is also expected to be present. State Senator Grady Hazlewood of Amarillo has already accepted an invitation to attend, and Fred Wimple of Midland, member of the Texas Highway Commission, has been invited.

Presidents of five colleges, Dr. W. M. Whyburn of Texas Tech, Dr. James P. Cornette of West Texas State, Dr. A. M. Mver of Amarillo College, Dr. Bill Marshall of Wayland College, and Dr. Floyd Golden of Portales are all expected to attend.

The prize list for the show is growing by leaps and bounds. Sears reports, and buyers from all over this section of the country have already indicated intention to be present for the show. With Boys Ranch taking a percentage of the sales, and some of the best show stock ever shown here entered in the show, sale prices are expected to top all records.

Judging for the show is slated for the morning hours, between 9 a. m. and 11:30, at the Bull Barn, where special show arenas are to be erected. The barbecue will take place at the Bull Barn at noon.

The parade is scheduled to follow a route from Lake Park down Main street to the Bull Barn.

The auction sale of show stock will be held at the arena following the parade, and the Calf Scramble, one of the most popular features of last year's program is planned to follow the sale.

Bleachers will be erected at the Bull Barn to accommodate large crowds expected for the sale and the Scramble to follow. —Hereford Brand.

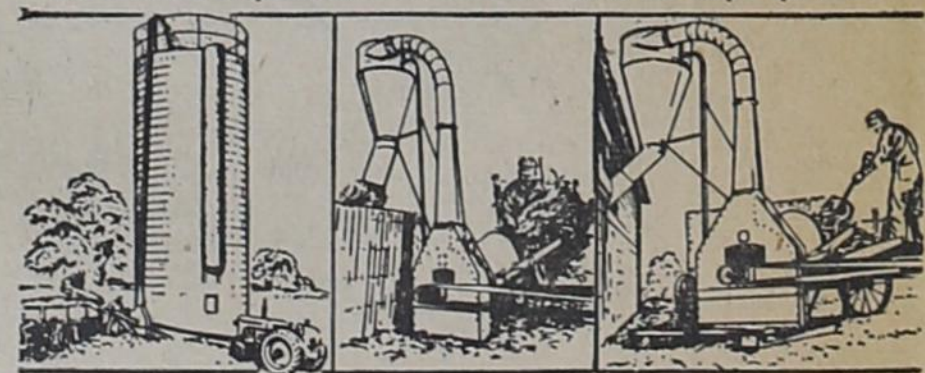

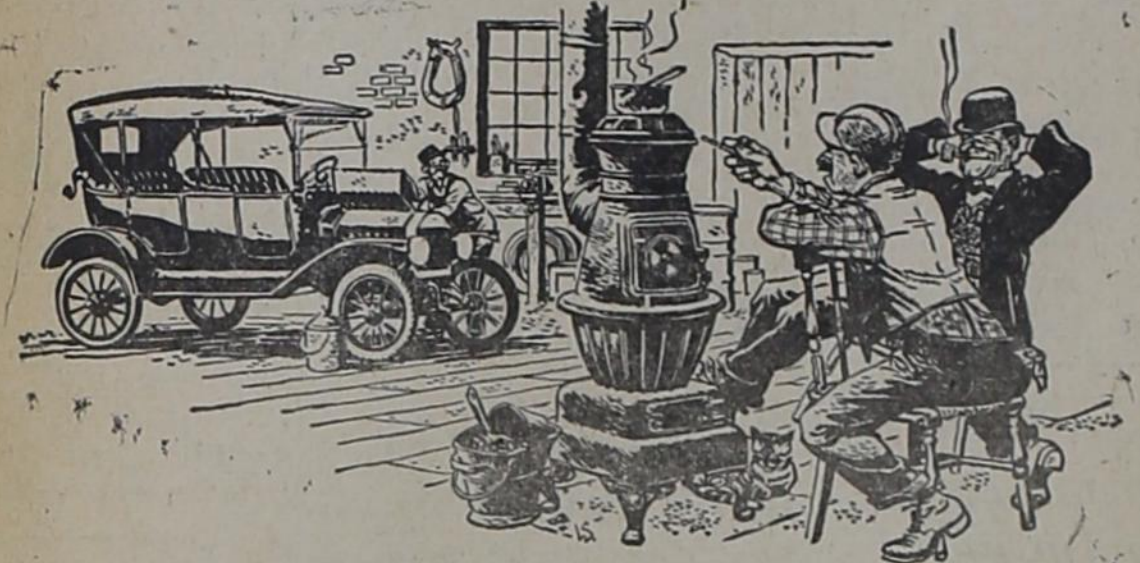

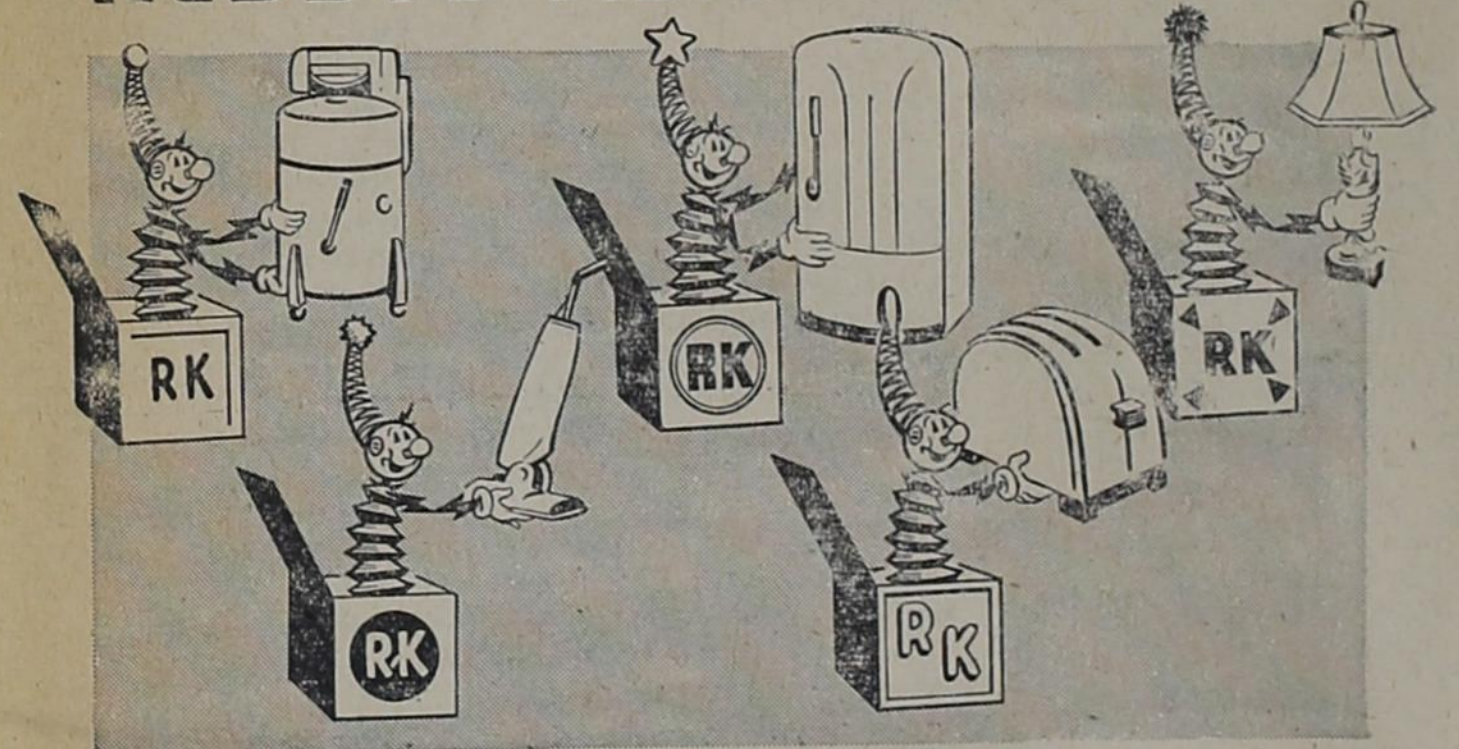

## Wholesome Milk Vital As Food Product

Austin, Texas—The production and distribution of milk is a business requiring great care in the handling of the product, as it is highly subject to contamination. Inasmuch as milk can be readily contaminated, control of production and distribution is necessary in the form of sanitary regulations. Milk that is produced and handled from farm to consumer, where sanitary precautions have been taken to make it a clean, wholesome product, is designated a Grade A milk, said Dr. Geo. W. Cox, State Health Officer.

In the production of Grade A milk, it must come from clean, and healthy cows. It is produced under conditions that will insure freedom from dust, dirt, and fly contamination in both the dairy barn and milk house. The dairy barn construction is such that it can be easily cleaned. Facilities are provided in the milk house to wash and sanitize utensils and equipment easily and quickly, and to store them in a place protected from contamination. Adequate cooling facilities are provided in the milk house so that the temperature of the milk can be lowered immediately after milking. It is the bacteria in milk that indicate the care with which

it is produced and handled.

Water supplies should be safe in order that no harmful bacteria may be introduced into milk from contaminated water in the process of washing and rinsing utensils. Carriers of disease organisms, or milk handlers who may be ill, can also introduce harmful organisms into a milk supply.

Pasteurization does not make a dirty milk clean. A clean quality milk can only be provided by having it produced and handled under sanitary standards. In brief, the consumer is assured that when Grade A pasteurized milk is used, it not only is a safe milk, but it has the added quality of being a clean milk.

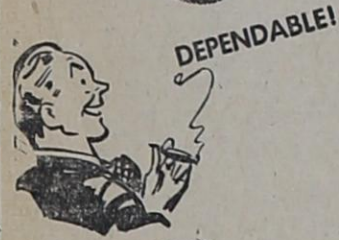

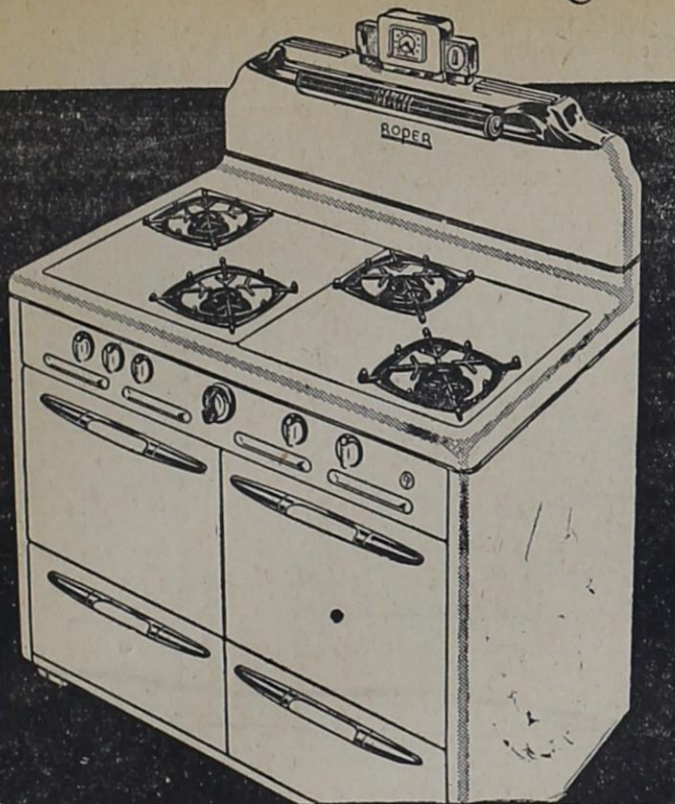

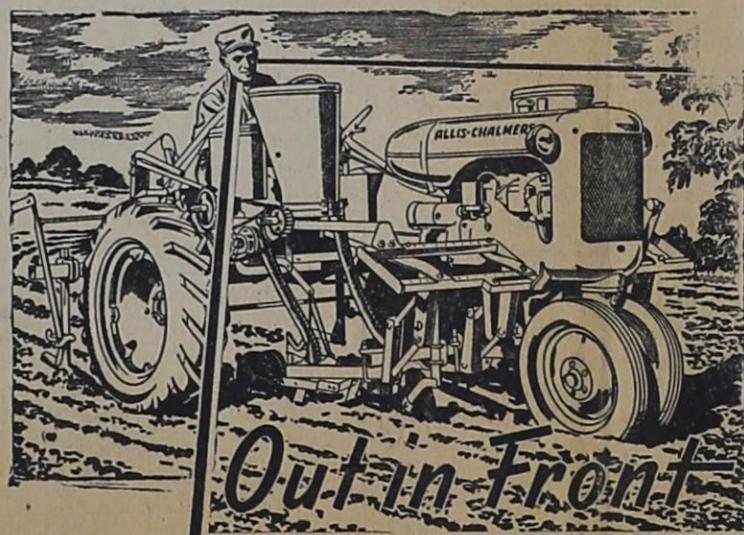

## Pledges 900,000 Elks to Aid Boy Scouts; 1475 Lodges Will Help Local Troops

The 1,475 lodges of Elksdom, representing some 900,000 members, have adopted for the coming year an aggressive plan to sponsor and assist financially the promotion of the Boy Scout program, Senior Scouting and Cub Scouting, especially in less privileged districts and neighborhoods, according to an announcement by Lafayette A. Lewis, of Los Angeles, newly elected Grand Exalted Ruler of the B.P.O.E. In this connection Colonel Charles Spencer Hart, past Grand Exalted Ruler, has been appointed to represent the Elks on the National Civic Relationships Committee of the Boy Scouts of America.

On a special trip to New York, Mr. Lewis conferred with Dr. Elbert K. Fretwell, chief Scout executive for the United States; Colonel Hart and Commander Thomas J. Keane, U.S.N.R., National Director of Civic Relations of the Boy Scouts of America, and developed plans for Elk participation.

"Already we have 300 lodges of Elks sponsoring Boy Scout troops and Cub Packs," Lewis declared, "but our goal is to have every one of our 1,475 lodges cooperate with from one to three local Scout units. More than one million boys—nearly 1,400,000—reach twelve years of age each year and 700,000 of them indicate they want to become Boy Scouts. Yet only 400,000 can be accepted because of insufficient sponsorship. We want to help provide Scouting facilities for the 300,000 left-overs and we

mean to furnish funds and offer many of our war veteran Elks as Scout leaders and committeemen.

"The 68,000 Boy Scout troops for nearly two million Scout members are not enough. We have seen militant minorities working for some revolution or other; why not the militant minority of Scout-trained citizens sponsored by Elks who stand for our best institutions and traditions?"

Mr. Lewis quoted with pride the figures of Admiral Chester Nimitz that 40 per cent of his men had been Boy Scouts and that 60 per cent of his decorated heroes had been Scouts.

The new Elks' chief has arranged itineraries totaling 150,000 miles of travel to subordinate lodges this year. On his visitations he plans to pledge more vigorously than ever the Elks' campaign against internal enemies of America. The particular targets of the Elks are the Ku Klux Klan, Communism, Fascism and other subversive elements.

In its 79-year history the B.P.O.E. has donated to worthy causes more than \$72,000,000, reaching a total of \$5,000,000 during the past year alone in addition to other sums given by local lodges. Lewis expects basic contributions this year will total more than \$12,000,000. Much of this will go for care of war veterans in 153 hospitals in 41 states, for the benefit of crippled children and toward college scholarships to outstanding secondary school students.

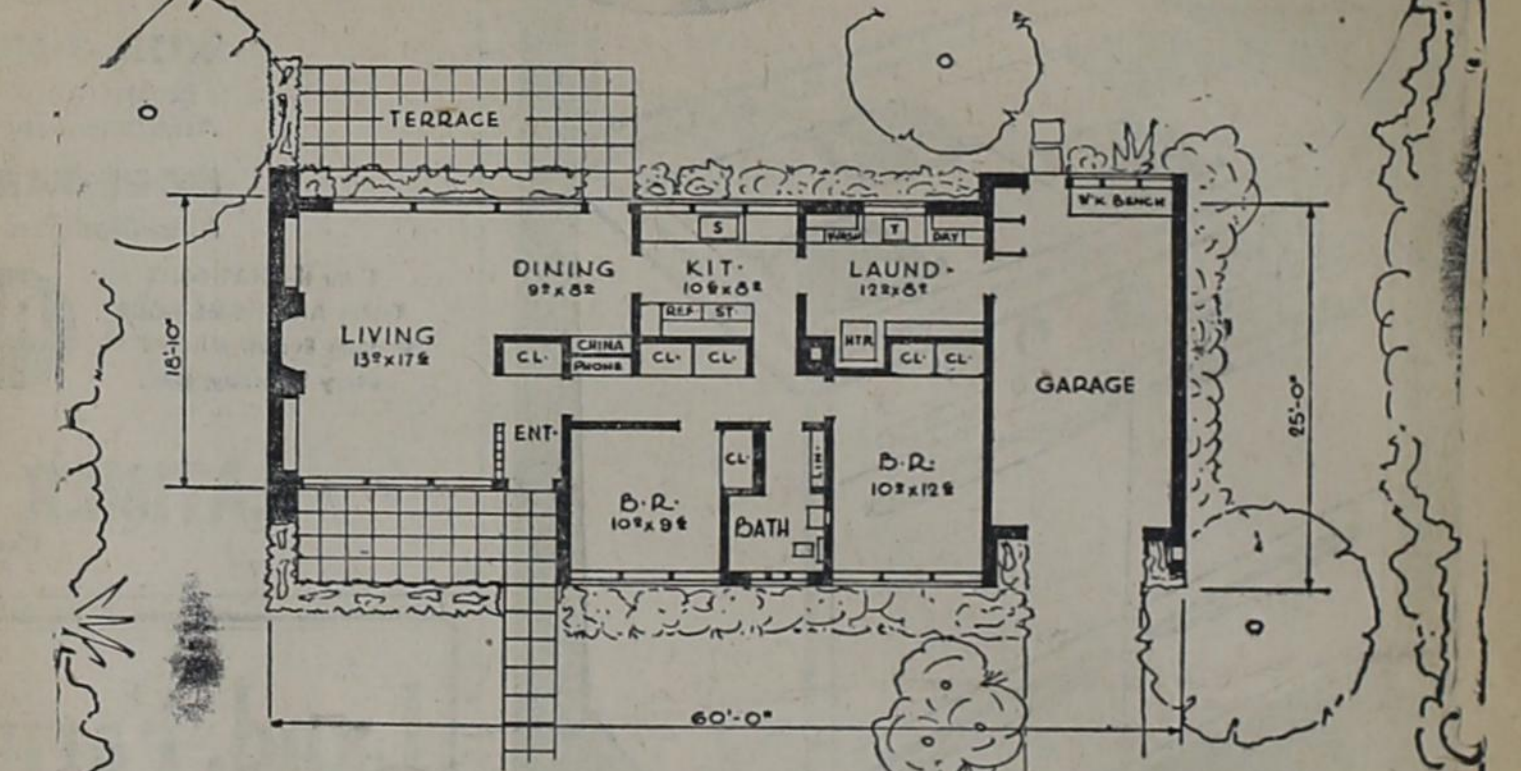
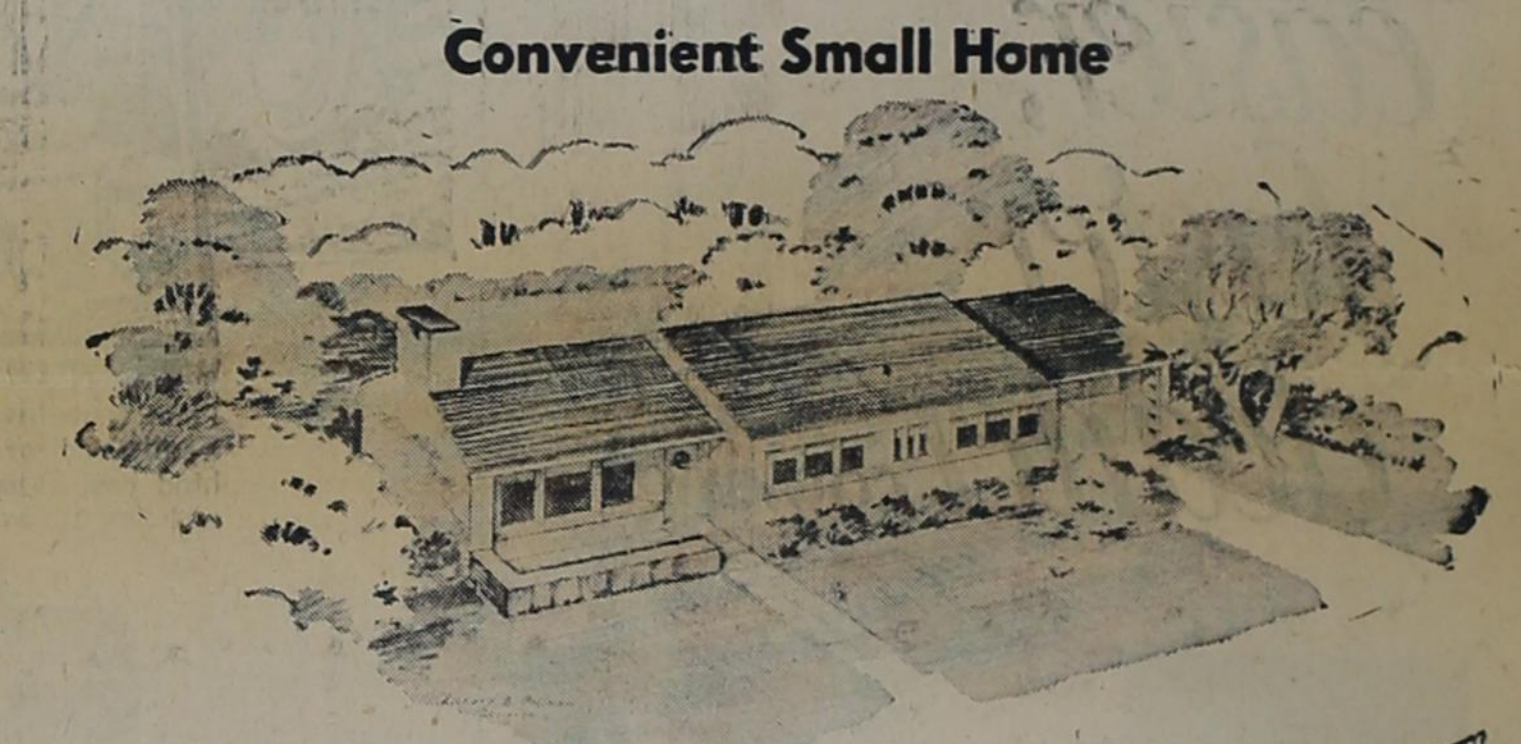
