A coroner gave a verdict that, Lambton died of a "sel--inflicted"

double-barreled shotgun that was found near the body.
The origin, circumstances and history of the ancient curse are
vague, and accounts fail to show how frequently the family suffered tragedy from the Twelfth century to modern times, but several mem-
