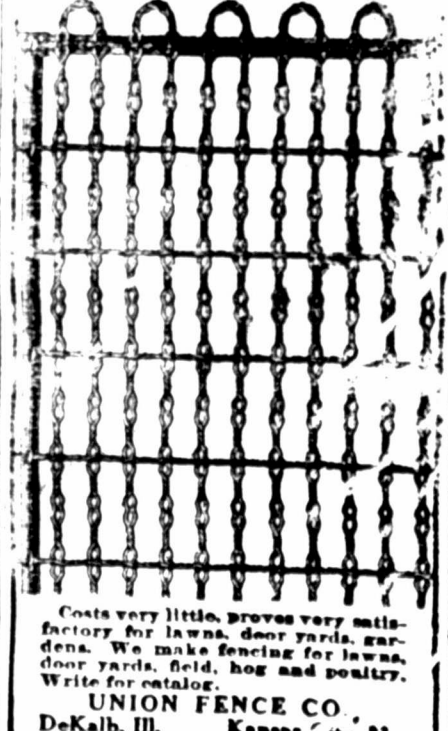
march and continued the soft and tender tones of the instrument during the ceremony.

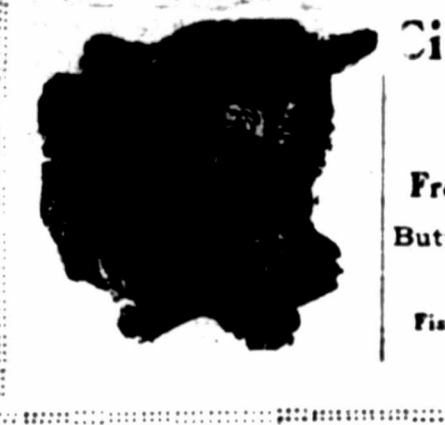
