SOME MISTAKES IN TREE PLANTING.

The growing of shade trees for city customers has been practiced so long by our American nurseries that the methods employed for this purpose by them have been accepted as the only correct methods of growing trees for planting.

The prospective forest tree planter is told that he should have large trees and that they should be two or three times transplanted before he receives them.

European foresters accomplish most by sowing the seeds where the trees are to remain.

By planting small trees the forest planter not only saves in the first cost of nursery stock, but he saves an immense amount of labor.

Seeds or nearly all of the broodlea trees should be transplanted into the forest site at the end of the first year.

A common mistake in tillage is to ridge the ground about the trees. This is of no advantage to the trees, and leaves the earth uneven in after years.

Some tree planters recommend mulching instead of cultivating. This is not a good practice in the arid districts.

drouth occurs these shallow roots will be injured. Cultivating is much superior to mulching, because the roots are hindered from coming too near the surface, and fine earth retards evaporation more effectually than mulch.
