Yesterday morning about dawn Mrs. Messer, the beloved wife of Rev. J. H. Messer, fell asleep in Jesus. For more than two days she appeared to be at the borderland, and husband and friends will never forget the hours when on Wednesday morning the veil obscuring the spirit world seemed to be drawn aside for her; even the attending physicians marveled at the abundance of vitality she exhibited in response to their strenuous efforts to combat the disease. But medical skill availed not and just as the night began to fade her spirit sped upward into that bright land where "there is no night." The last words that her husband heard were "Wash me, dear Jesus, and I shall be whiter than snow."

The churches and the entire community are deeply stirred. Never perhaps have some hearts felt so definitely the reality and blessedness of that world beyond. The death of a mother in Israel and her translation to glory have awakened other hearts to more loyal service to the Master and thus even in her death the glorious gospel exhibits its victorious power.

Funeral services were conducted yesterday afternoon at four o'clock in the Methodist church, in the presence of a large audience. A brief service followed at the graveyard. Interment here is temporary as the body will some day be laid away near the home of her youth.

At the World's Fair.

The masses of mankind who enjoy eating meat even at the present high prices have an opportunity to witness the workings of a big packing house plant at the World's Fair. St. Joseph has prepared a model of that city's packing houses, showing the details of slaughtering, clearing and handling cattle, sheep and hogs in the big modern packing houses. The model is a faithful reproduction of the St. Joseph livestock interests, including railroads, sheds, switch yards and all other properties used in the handling of stock.

The spectator may lean upon a brass railing and through the glass windows of an idealized packing house may observe the workings of the various departments. The cattle and hog killing rooms, the engine and boiler rooms, the interiors of the chicken house, oil house and bone house are visible, and the more or less elaborate processes in each will be reproduced by the action of clockwork upon tiny figures of men and beasts. This is the only portion of the exhibit in which there will be moving parts. The remainder is devoted to a miniature stockyards with cattle, hogs and sheep standing about in pens, to the packing houses and railroads. Ex.
