An ordinance regulating the speed of railway trains; prohlbiting railroad companies from obstructing and blockading the street purposes.
Be it ordained by the board of trustees of the town of Portales, New Mexico: It shall be unlawful for apy railway engineer, conductor, yardmaster, permanently or temporarily, of any railway engine, train, car or cars, to allow, suffer or permit any railway engine, car or cars, to remain across or ppon any open street or road within the
town lifitt for alonger perrod than five minutes at any one time,
except it be in case of inevitable aceident or casualty. except it be in case of inevitable aceident or casualt
employ of a railroad company operating through the town of Por tapes to get upon freight or other cars in said town of Portales,
for the purpose of braking or riding on the same, or for any other for the parpose of braking or riding on the same, or for any other
purpose, except as a passenger coming or going from the station in
