water who usually think of Christianity as a milk and water proposition, may be interested in reports from the distributing agencies for the testaments, report that the bible is the most popular book in the trenches, and that the demand is far greater than the present supply. The trials and temptations of war make a demand on the spiritual stamina of man, and everywhere he is turning toward old values and virtues.

makes the Christian religion so comforting and sustaining to the man in the trenches.
