# GERMAN ARMORED DIVISION CRUSHES DANES

MRS. J. W. MANCILL BURIED AT 10 A. M. TODAY

Funeral services were held today at 10 a.m. at the residence, 902 Franklin street, for Mrs. Alice Mancill, widow of the late James Wadsworth Mancill, former mayor of Cisco, who died Oct. 16, 1926. Interment was made in Greenwood cemetery, with Rev. George L. Clegg in charge of the service and burial.

Mrs. Mancill died in a Dallas hospital Sunday afternoon at about 8 o'clock, where she had been for treatment following a short illness. Her only surviving child, Mrs. Maurine Royal, resides in Dallas, and was hoping that the superior facilities of the Dallas institution could restore her health.

Rev. Cooper Waters, pastor of First Baptist church, of which Mrs. Mancill had been a member for about 12 years, preached at the service. L. W. Seymour, pastor of First Methodist church, and a close neighbor of Mrs. Mancill, also served in the services, and described her as a splendid neighbor, saying that she was the first person to call on them when they received their new pastorate.

Mrs. Mancill had been a member of the First Baptist church for the past 45 years, the only woman being born there. Deceased was born near Cisco, September 29, 1879. Her parents both died in her early childhood and she was reared by Mrs. Ben Jones, Mrs. Dave Jones, or "Aunt Kate." Mrs. Jones was always like a mother to Mrs. Mancill.

Mrs. Mancill had lived at the present residence on the east side of town for the past 45 years, the only children being born there. Deceased was born near Cisco, September 29, 1879. A. M. Alice Joplin, she was married to J. W. Mancill, Feb. 1, 1890, and from this union two children were born. Mrs. Royal of Dallas resides. The son, Edward Mancill, was killed in an accident at Victoria, Tex., Sept. 27, 1937.

**COVER CROPS  
WALTER BOYD WILL PREVENT  
LAID TO REST WIND EROSION  
HERE SUNDAY**

Eastland county farmers will meet soon to plan steps to protect their peanut land from wind erosion after harvesting, says County Agent Floyd Lynch. Meetings have been called for Cisco, Gorman, Ranger and Eastland to introduce the program and to take farmers' and ranchers' applications for cover crop seed.

Rye is the most generally recommended cover crop since it is adapted to sandy soils and is more winter-hardy. Legumes that some of the more experienced farmers plant to mix with rye is a mixture of vetch and sustaria winter peas.

## DEPUTY COLLECTORS TO AID TAXPAYER

One out of every three taxpayers will be required to file declarations of their earned income and victory taxes for the year 1943 on or before September 15, 1943. Farmers, considered to be those persons receiving at least 80 percent of their gross income from farming operations (as distinguished from agricultural laborers receiving wages or salaries), must file declarations on or before December 15.
