usually involves attitudes and disciplines which must start in the home and, if absent, result in fatal defects in the child, the youth and the man.

"For Liberty is actually a disciplined attitude toward life and toward others.

"Liberty does not result in a wild gallop across time and space and the lives of others, heedlessly ignoring their rights and their wishes.

"True Liberty is conducted within the framework of law and rules of decency with the result that any enjoyment of the beautiful freedoms this land delivers to us results in no pain and no injury to any other human being.

"This means that any free life must be lived within, and be governed by a code of honesty, of fair dealing, and of respect for all other human beings, including those whose opinions differ utterly and completely from our own, and whose views, political, religious or otherwise may in no sense whatever match your views or mine.

"If a single word has to be restored to describe the good man—the good citizen—and the good father—it is the word INTEGRITY.

"If it were in my power to bestow on the youth of the land one single quality, I would not choose, I think, wit or wisdom, or even that great boon, education. If I could choose but one—I would choose integrity.

"If one day my children and grandchildren say to each other, 'He taught us to value integrity,' I shall be content.

"How is the quality of integrity passed on to the children in the home? It is passed on by living a life of integrity, of sober honesty, of responsible citizenship.

"How can one surely fail to pass this priceless quality on to children in the home?

"By being a little lawless; by being a fixer; by being a cheat and a chiseler.

"Mrs. Welch and I have two children with a facility in the use of words. Not so long ago one of them spoke these sobering words to me. He said, 'When the two of us were young, there were times when you and Mom would obviously set out to tell us how to live the good life. We could always recognize those moments and we would close our ears and our minds. Your most influential moments were your most inadvertent ones. We were apt to imitate what you really weren't what you said you were, or even what you may have believed you were.'

"I leave that sobering thought with you. If your children are to have INTEGRITY, they must first find it in the home and in you. If they live in an atmosphere of complete integrity they will accept it as an attitude and never waver thereafter. And having integrity, they will themselves find freedom, and having found it, gladly grant it to all others."
