This Week End Games Broadcast By Humble Oil

Humble continues to bring the action of the Southwest Conference race to football fans this Saturday with two conference and two inter-sectional tilts on the broadcast schedule.

A conference battle finds Texas U. and Rice clashing at Austin. This game takes the air at 2:15 p. m. with Kern Tipton describing the plays and Alex Chesser assisting with color highlights. Stations

to air the tussle are KPRC, Houston; WOAI San Antonio; WFAA-WDAF, Dallas-Ft. Worth; KRGV, Waco; and KTBC, Austin.

In the other conference fray of the afternoon, A. & M. meets Baylor at College Station; Charlie Jordan handling the play-by-play while Dick Bush describes the color. Broadcast of this game starts at 2:15 p. m. over stations KGKO, Dallas-Ft. Worth; KTSA, San Antonio; KXYZ, Houston; KRIS, Corpus Christi; KEKW, Brownsville; WTAU, College Station; and WACO, Waco.

Oklahoma A. & M. travels to Ft. Worth to tangle with T.C.U. in an inter-sectional tilt. Game time is 2:15 p. m. Bill Michaels and Fred Kincaid doing the play-by-play and color respectively. WRB, Dallas; KPJZ, Ft. Worth; KTEM, Temple; KNOW, Austin; KMAC, San Antonio; KRBC, Abilene; KEST, Big Spring; KGKL, San Angelo; KRLH, Midland; KTHI, Houston; KPRO, Longview; and KWRU, Corpus Christi will carry this broadcast.

Another inter-sectional conflict brings S.M.U. against Tulane at New Orleans. Announcers for the game are Ves Box, calling the plays and Dave Russell the color. Broadcast time for this tilt is 2:00 p. m. over stations KRLD, Dallas; KTRH Houston; and KABC, San Antonio.

Spring Gardeners Average \$106.73 On 1945 Crop

COLLEGE STATION, Tex. — Each Texas Spring gardener grew a thousand pounds of vegetables this year, netting \$106.73, according to an average estimated by Texas A. & M. College horticulturists.

Farmers, knowing more about agriculture than the city dweller, obtained an average \$109 yield from his spring garden while the city garden valued at an average of \$38.

The net sum is about 21 per cent below the money spring gardeners amassed last year. This is partially explained by the fact that the number of spring gardens decreased about 12 per cent.
