Chemists Are Developing Fire Fighting Paint

PITTSBURGH (UP)—A new paint designed to help combat the spread of fire is near final development at the Mellon Institute of Industrial Research.

Research experts H. D. Cogan, and C. A. Setterstrom reported to the American Chemical Society that the paint, in addition to being heat-resistant, will not darken with age.

By mixing a colorless liquid of ethyl silicate with pigments, the researchers said they developed paints which will strongly combat the elements of weather and chemical fumes—making the pro-

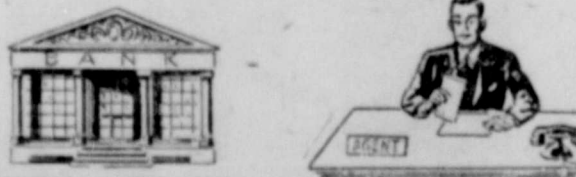

Camp Howze Sale Lasts Through December Sixth

FORT WORTH (Special)—Heating equipment, building material and supplies salvaged from the dismantling of Camp Howze, near Gainesville, will go on sale from November 25 through December 6 at the camp, it was announced today by War Assets Administration. Among material offered will be theater benches, store counters, plumbing fixtures and lumber remaining from two previous site sales. Value of the total stock to be sold is \$450,000. Opening day of the sale, Monday, will be reserved to purchasers by the federal government. Following five days ending November 29 will be devoted to certified veterans of World War II. Sales will not be conducted Thanksgiving Day, November 28, however.

For resale to small businesses the Reconstruction Finance Corporation is scheduled to make purchases Dec. 2. The following day, December 3, will be devoted to sale to state and local governments during the morning, and eligible non-profit institutions during the afternoon.

Final three days of the sale, December 4 and 6, will be open to buying by non-priority commercial buyers. The camp is located five miles north of Gainesville on highway 77.



Veterans Making Inquiries Slow Down VA Service

Veterans who make repeated inquiries of claims against the VA are unknowingly slowing down the service they want, the VA said today.

The education and training division of the Dallas Regional Office, which has the files of about 80,000 men and women attending school or enrolled in job training, said some veterans were making repeated calls about checks and other benefits.

In all these inquiries, reference must be made to the veteran's file.

"Sometimes," said E. M. Cain, chief of the division, "we are just about ready to send a vet's file to the finance division when an inquiry must be followed through. That delays final action."

The VA said it was not discouraging veterans from asking benefits, either through contact representatives or service organizations. But, said the VA, one inquiry is sufficient, and it is sufficient.
