**Bear, Wolf And Elk Fall To Russian Hunters**

MOSCOW (UP)—Six hundred brown bears and 185 wolves were killed in the year ending March 25, 1947, in Archangel province, the newspaper Izvestia reported. Nearly 250,000 rubles were paid in bounties by the state for the slaying of the beasts, which in the

same year had killed 2,500 horses and cows and 1,780 smaller cat-tel.

During the winter hunting season in Archangel province, which has just ended, more than 2,000 elk were killed. They were turned over to state-owned restaurants.

**Historic Flushing House Is Made Tolerance Shrine**

NEW YORK (U. I.)—Bowne House in Flushing, which was built

in 1661 and is one of the oldest houses in New York City, has been formally opened as a shrine of religious tolerance and freedom.

The house was built 286 years ago by John Bowne, who held Quaker meetings in it. Originally it had a small kitchen and three small rooms, but other rooms, making a total of 21, were added before 1750. Nine generations of descendants of John Bowne lived in the home continuously.

Hostesses will guide visitors through the rooms, which have

wide, rough boards in the floors, low ceilings, windows with old glass panes, an antique furniture used by the early occupants. It will be operated by the Bowne House Historical Society.
