AMARILLO, March 28 (UP)—Mrs. Bertha Brinkley, sentenced to serve two years in the state penitentiary for giving false testimony at the murder trial of her son, has been freed on \$2,500 appeal bond.

Her son, Orla Brinkley, was tried and acquitted of murder in the death of his infant step son. Five other persons, including Brinkley's wife, still face trial on charges of perjury at his trial.

Houston Man's Slayer Sought

BEAUMONT, Tex. March 28.—(UP)—South Texas police moved today to find the trail of William Earl (Bill) Pelham, 25, one of three Houston hotel employes charged in the slaying of Elbert Langston, 22.

Langston, formerly of Florence, S. C., was found shot to death at noon Saturday in a Rice Paddy near Nome, Tex., in west Jefferson County. His body was nude except for underwear shorts and shoes.

Henry Robert Giles, Jr., 30, Houston, and John Carston Brunson, Jr., 23, Houston, both admitted they had been with Pelham and Langston Friday night. Brunson surrendered through an attorney to the sheriff's department early Saturday morning, and Giles was arrested as he sat in a car near the city hall.

Jefferson County Sheriff Charley Meyer said Giles had admitted shooting Langston three times, and Pelham stripped the body, taking a small amount of cash, believed to be about \$30. Funeral home attendants said \$200 in Langston's

socks was overlooked.

The four men were all employes at the new Shamrock Hotel in Houston, and lived together, Giles said. Brunson, a former resident of Florence, S. C., was a life-long friend of the victim, he related.

J. & J. Oil Co. No. 1 Jones was treated Wednesday but from all indications it will need another good dose of acid or something to make it produce commercially. The output now will not make much more than 2 or 3 bbls. per day — just a trickle.

AUSTIN, Tex., March 28 (UP) — A total of 182 oil wells were completed in Texas during the last week, bringing the total for this year to 1,922, the Texas Railroad Commission reported today.

During the same period last year, 1,508 wells were brought in. Dry holes during the last week numbered 97, while gas completions totaled 16.

New Orleans In Spot On Scandal

(UP) — New Orleans' multi-million dollar wooing of South America today threatened to turn into an estrangement as serious as that of "Miss New Orleans of 1948" and her air-line pilot husband.

A Colombian newspaper has already demanded that New Orleans apologize for the "scandal" involving 18-year-old Barbara Jean Floyd Cauthen and her husband, Capt. George Cauthen.

They were married in Medellin, Colombia, while Miss Floyd was on a goodwill tour of South America as a representative of New Orleans.

The whole thing threatened to boomerang this weekend when the bride announced that she doesn't want to be one. She said she married Cauthen, assistant chief pilot for a Colombian subsidiary of Pan American Airlines, just to get free transportation back to the United States.

The couple met in a hotel lobby here after Cauthen flew from Colombia to confirm reports that his bride wanted a divorce.

Nadine came home last Sunday, a week following her disappearance after inserting a "lost" ad in the Cushing Daily Citizen. The money she lost had been given her by her brother for delivery to her parents.

When Mr. and Mrs. Leo Myers of Oilton, Okla., visited Cushing relatives and read Nadine's story, they took her money to her home. Their four-year-old grandson, Gary Charles Panches of Fampa, Tex., had found it March 12, shortly after Nadine lost it, on the floor of a Cushing store. Mr. and Mrs. Myers had deposited it in a drumwright bank while they waited to find the owner.

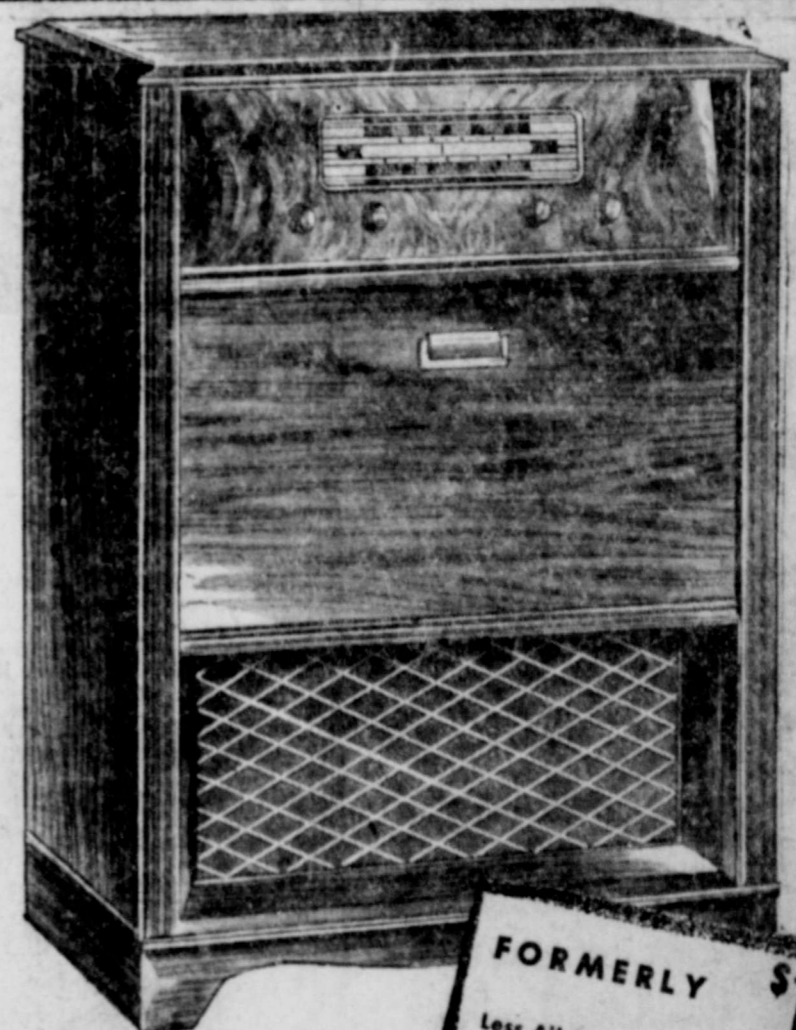
