A number of ten pure bred Angus and Hereford steer calves to be prefloats were docked with flowers sented to ten outstanding FFA and 4-H Club boys of this area. Twenty qualified boys were allowed to scramble for these ten calves. On catching a calf and taking him across a designated line each boy catching a calf was awarded that calf to feed or raise as his own, showing him in local livestock shows, under the guidance of his Vocational Agriculture teacher or County Agent.


