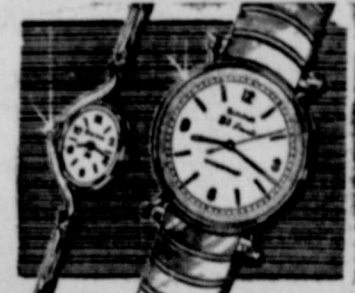

## Reconstruction Hwy. 183 North Set Near Future

All interested persons are advised that reconstruction and improvement of US Highway 183 from its intersection with FM Highway 1032 in Stephens County to its intersection with State Highway 6 in Eastland County is being planned by the Texas Highway Commission. The contemplated location is along the existing highway except for relocations to eliminate poor alignment near the Eastland-Stephens County line. Additional right of way will be secured on either or both sides of the existing right of way when dictated by location or design requirements and new right of way will be secured in the areas of relocation to conform to the latest design requirements. The proposed highway rebuilding of the existing highway to the design requirements for a two-lane paved highway with paved shoulders. Notice is hereby given that any interested citizen, groups or governmental agencies may request that a combined public hearing be held respecting the route and design of the highway facility and the social, economic and environmental effects of the design of said facility on the community and highway users by delivering a written request to the Resident Engineer, Texas Highway Department, Post Office Box 1126, Breckenridge, Tex. 76624 on or before the first day of April, 1969.

In the event such request is received, a public hearing will be scheduled and adequate notice will be given as to its time and place.

Data relating to relocation assistance programs, maps, drawings and other pertinent information developed by the Texas Highway Department and written views of other interested persons or agencies will be available for public inspection and copying during normal working hours at the Resident Engineers' office.

Funds for reconstruction of this section of highway have

been approved by the Texas Highway Commission. Plan preparation and supervision & inspection of construction will be under the direction of J. B. Bunnann, Senior Resident Engineer, Breckenridge, Tex.

Brannan stated that the approximate cost of this project will be \$1,000,000 with approximately \$300,000 of the funds being supplied by regular federal aid programs to the State Highway Department. Plan preparation and submission of right of way deeds to the county will be completed after approval has been received for location and design.
