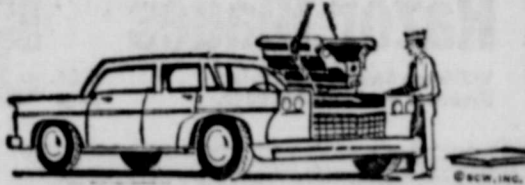

**Brush and Range Control Short Course at Eastland**

Brush control and range management will be the topics discussed at a range management short course in Eastland Sept. 10 and 11. County Agent De Gordon says the 2-night short course was planned to help Eastland County livestockmen improve their range land for more profitable production.

Dr. Bobby Joe Ragsdale, Extension Service Range Management Specialist from Texas A&M, will discuss brush control on Wednesday night, Sept. 10. Gordon says brush is

one of the rancher's biggest problems. On Thursday night, Dr. Ragsdale will discuss systematic deferment, stocking rates and grazing systems.

Each session starts at 8 p.m. and will be in the Farm Bureau Building on Highway 80 east of Eastland.

Everyone interested in range management is encouraged to attend the short course.

The county agent says that profit from ranching depends on the operator's ability to manage and use all available range resources.

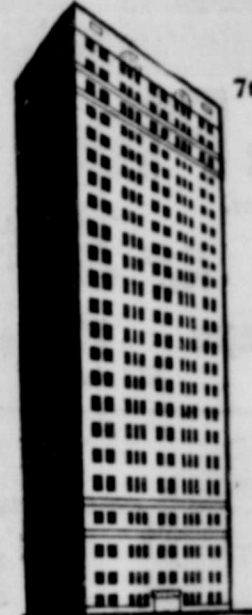

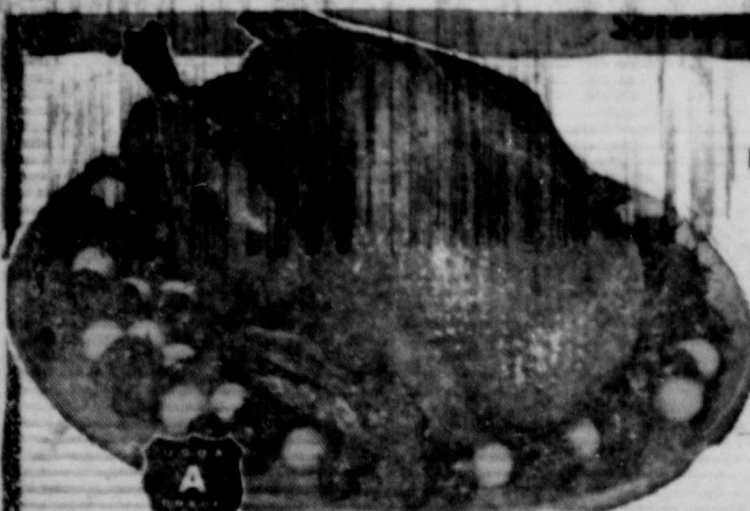

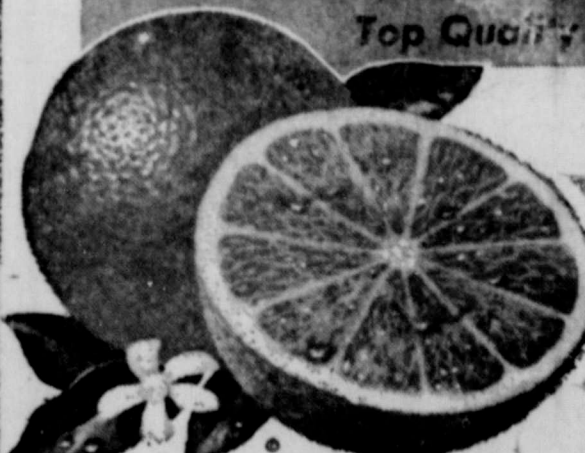
