#### Abstract

These sales will be conducted under the supervision of Dwight W. Tuttle, H. C. Linn and Geo. A. Alexander, Townsite Commissioners for the Creek Nation. DEEDS to these town lots will be executed by the Principal Chief of the Creek Nation and approved by the Secretary of the Interior. The DEED of the Principal Chief conveys all title of the Creek Nation and the approval of the Secretary of the Interior operates as a relinquishment to the grantee of all right, title and interest of the United States and thus makes a PERFECT TITLE GUARANTEED BY THE GOVERNMENT: All lots will be sold at auction to the highest bidder under the following terms as stipulated in Clause 15 , of an Act to ratify and confirm an agreement with the Muskogee or Creek tribe of Indians, approved March 1st, 1901.


"When the appraisement of any town lot is made, upon which any person has improvements as aforesaid, said appraisement commission shall notify him of the amount of said appraisement, and he shall, within sixty days thereafter, make payment of ten per centum of the amount due for the lot, as herein provided, and four months thereafter he shall pay fifteen per centum additional, and the remainder of the purchase money in three equal annual instaliments, whe the panum until paid. The per per annum until paid. The purchaser may in any case at any time make full payment for any town lot.

Copies of the plats of these towns can be purchased at nominal prices, and printed lists showing the numbers of the lots for sale can be secured by addressing the Townsite Commission, at Eufaula, or the United States Indian Inspector, at Muskogee, Indian Territory.
