| Austin, Feb. 20.-The senate postponed unti next Tuesday the consideration of the special order, the Frisco consolidation bitt. <br> The house concurrent resolution providing for the appointment of a committee to negotiate for the purchase of McArdle's painting of the battle of San Jacinto was adopted, after the preamble was stricken out by amendment. <br> Senator Davidson of DeWitt had engrossed his bill limiting domestic corporations to have only one place of business. <br> Senator Brachfield secured the final passage of his bill validating the incorporation of cities and towns which have included too much territory in their limits, and giving them ninety days within which to reduce the excess. <br> Sonator Paulus had the rules suspended and his bill finally passed, authorizing towns or less than 3000 intants to abolish the position of marshal, if they so desire. <br> The speaker laid before the house the special order, the committee substitute for house bills 5, 4 and 39, providing for working sicort term con victs upon, the public roads of the state and defining short term convicts. <br> An amendment by Mr. Ponton correcting printing errors was adopted. <br> An amendment by Messrs. Wooten, Terrell of McLennan and Fowler, providing that no county should be enhad not first put its county convicts to work o nthe public roads, was adopted. <br> Original bill as amended was passed |
