Market Quotations

NORTH FORT WORTH, Sept. 17.—Receipts of cattle today, with about twenty cars in, amounted to close around 1,600 head.

Supplies of steers, including driven-ins, were fairly liberal, and of from medium to well finished grades. There was a good active strong demand from packers and about all of the supply was weighed to them on a steady basis with yesterday.

Butcher stock supplies were light, and all offerings found an active demand on a steady basis. Sales were mostly to butchers and packers at a range of from \$1.50 to \$2.25.

There was no noticeable change in quotations for hogs. The few on the market sold largely around \$1.75.

Supplies of calves were quite liberal and composed the bulk of supplies. There is still a strong demand for all grades of killing calves and trading lively and steady.

The usual light Saturday run of hogs came in today. Only three shipments arrived, with about 200 head. The quality was hardly as good as that of yesterday, but the good demand from packers cleaned up the supply in a short time, and the general trade ruled active and strong compared with yesterday.

SALES AT SAN ANGELO. SAN ANGELO, Texas, Sept. 16.—E. A. Finn of Cameron, Texas, purchased yesterday from John Kennedy of Fort McKavett three carloads of Poll-Angus steers, the majority being three and four-year-olds, for which he paid \$35 around, the remainder two were purchased at \$20 a head.

There seems rather an active demand at present for steer cattle for feeding. Few sales are being reported because of the stiff prices asked by the stockmen. Steers are also scarce in this country.
