JOHN B. HAWLEY ADDRESSES MAYORS Urges Municipal Ownership of Waterworks and Speaks of Texas Artesian Supply

An address to the Mayors' Association at Mineral Wells by John B. Hawley, city engineer of Fort Worth and consulting engineer for North Fort Worth water works system now under course of construction, was read at Wednesday afternoon session of the convention.

The uses of public water supplies are generally divided into three classes: domestic, public and commercial.

In the writer's opinion, the first, water for domestic use, the water people must drink, cook with and bathe in, is that of prime import.

That fire protection is a very great function of water works, none will deny, and yet, care in construction and use of buildings can minimize the terrors of the fire demon.

It is apparent, without discussion, that water for purely commercial purposes, factories, car-washing, etc., the last place in the scale of importance.

With the exception of a few comparatively small areas, Texas has been peculiarly well blessed by the Creator, in opportunities for good public water supplies.

Fort Worth System Growing Fort Worth is now extending her artesian system several miles farther, up the artesian basin.
