

The Lockney City Council met in a short session for their November meeting. The first discussion on the agenda was the amending of the budget to allow for the repair of two pumps for the sewer

The pumps were installed in 1960 and according to Dan Smith, "The years have taken their toll and we have been

lucky that they have lasted 30 years." The bill for the repairing of the pumps

came to \$13,375.00 and as this was an unbudgeted item the budget had to be amended to include the cost of the re-

Discussion was held on an application that a variance be granted to allow a trailer house to be moved onto a lot on N.E. 4th Street. The council reported that the applicant would be given the opportunity to comply with the regulations before the trailer is moved into town and that if he complied with the building code that the variance would be

granted. The stipulations are that a concrete drive for one car and a concrete sidewalk around the trailer must be provided. The wiring and plumbing must be in compliance with the city code and the trailer must be skirted soon after it is moved on the site. The trailer must pass inspection as is any house or trailer being moved inside the city limits.

The Lockney City Council would like to remind the citizens that TIRES WILL NO LONGER BE ACCEPTED AT THE CITY LANDFILL unless they are shredded, quartered or halved. The E.P.A. regulations will no longer let landfills accept whole tires.

In regular business of the council the minutes of the previous meeting were read by Irma Lee Duckworth, city secretary, and approved as read. The financial statement was reviewed. Current bills were discussed and members of the council voted that they be paid.

A brief school board meeting was held Friday from 3:18 - 4:00 p.m." by LISD, November 8, at 7:30 p.m.



BBB inundated by calls about unclaimed funds

ceived many calls from consumers who received a letter from Federal Information Services out of Dallas. The recipient or someone with the same surname, is being offered a possible refund on property. Based on the number of calls received your Bureau believes that there was an extensive massmailing sent to not only Lubbock residents but the Whole South Plains.

The Dallas Better Business Bureau reports that the company has been known in their area since November 1989. The company sells information on a work-at-home opportunity tracing individuals who may have refunds due them from the federal government. The company has been the subject of complaints at BBB/Dallas alleging that its

The Better Business Bureau has re- mailing was deceptive. The company responded to complaints by offering refunds.

> The BBB/South Plains is concerned that people will become overly excited about the prospects of a refund and call the "900" number or send the \$15.00 fee when, in fact, they could get the same information from the government free

The only way you can be eligible for a possible refund is if you have PAID OFF a FHA 30-year fixed-rate home loan. If you believe you are due a refund, you should write to the U.S. Department of HUD, Distributive Shares Premium Refunds Section, 451 7th St., SW. Washington, DC 20410 or call 743-7262 here in Lubbock.

New area codes for some cities

Beginning Sunday, November 4, when people calling long distance call to about 200 cities in North and Northeast Texas, they will use the new area code 903 instead of the 214 area code used in the past. Cities in and around the metropolitan Dallas area will retain the 214 area code.

Generally speaking, the area changing to the new 903 area code can be described as follows: East of Terrell to the Arkansas and Louisiana lines, North of Celina and Anna to Oklahoma, and West and Southwest to previous 214 area code boundaries.

"Growth in the Dallas metropolitan area is the cause for the change," according to Mike Flynn, Vice President-Network-Texas, for Southwestern Bell in Dallas. "Our studies showed the current 214 area code would have run out of available numbers in late 1991."

To make the transition easier for telephone customers served by Southwestern Bell and other telephone companies impacted by the change, callers failing to use the 903 area code will be able to complete their calls during a grace period of about six months. After the grace period, use of the correct area code for the city being called (either 214 or 903) will be mandatory.

"About 600,000 access lines in this part of Texas will have a new area code (903)," Flynn said. "Customers have been given a year or more notice or lead time, so the change should not result in any serious problems. Changes like this have been made in Texas, and across the country in recent years, and customers everywhere have made the change with minimal difficulty."

The need for the new 903 code, increased consumption of available threedigit numbers due to economic growth, is a positive for the state of Texas. "It's just one more indicator things are beginning to pick up economically. We hope it's a forerunner to a consistently accelerating growth rate, because everyone benefits when this happens," Flynn said. Texas will have eight area codes in

DPS warns travelers to take precautions

Major Vernon Cawthon, Regional Commander of the Texas Department of Public Safety in Lubbock, stated, "That this Thanksgiving Holiday weekend, thousands more drivers will be on the streets and highways. Some drivers will only be going across town — others will be crossing several states."

Major Cawthon also said, "The Department of Public Safety wants you to have a safe and pleasant holiday, so if you are planning a trip out of town, check your car, the road conditions, the weather conditions, and your driving habits. Remember, that the early darkness and heavy traffic call for more caution and less speed."

Homeowners 65 or older may now pay taxes in installments

Homeowners 65 or older may now pay the taxes on their current homesteads in four installments. Most elderly homeowners received their home tax bills this month.

Leon Willhite, executive director of the State Property Tax Board, explained the purpose of the new installment payment option authorized by state law beginning this September.

"In past years, older homeowners had to pay their entire home tax bill before the normal February 1 delinquency date of pay a penalty and interest on the unpaid amount. This was a hardship for many elderly homeowners with fixed incomes," Willhite said. "This new provision gives them the option of spreading out that payment," he said.

To set up installment payments, 65or-older homeowners must pay at least one-fourth of their 1990 residence homestead taxes before the February 1 delinquency date. Then, three equal installments are due before April 1, June 1, and August 1.

If all installments are paid on time, homeowners will not be charged penalty or interest for late payment, Willhite said. However, those who fail to pay an installment on time must pay penalty and interest on that installment.

Homeowners 65 or older who are interested in arranging installments need to contact the tax collection office for each taxing unit - county, city, school, or special district — at the address on their tax bills.

This new provision does not apply to any past home taxes already delinquent or other types of property.




UIL Superconference was held in Lubbock Saturday. These meetings inform teachers and students of rules and tips on participating in academic UIL activities for the Spring.
