Sonora To Host National Wool Judging Contest

Judging teams representing 4-H Clubs from across the nation will assemble here June 15-17 to compete in the 1976 National 4-H Wool Judging Contest.

In addition to the national event, junior wool and mohair and open wool and mohair shows will be held. Participants in the junior all-Texas wool and mohair show will compete in the categories of livestock, wool, mohair and range. Both 4-H Club and Future Farmers of America teams and individuals are eligible to enter the all-Texas show.

Registration for the wool and mohair and open shows will be held at 5 p.m., Tuesday (June 15) with judging Wednesday (June 16). Registration for the National 4-H Wool Judging Contest will be held at 5 p.m., Wednesday (June 16) with judging on Thursday (June 17). All shows will culminate Thursday with an awards luncheon at the 4-H Center here where plaques, medals and a rotation trophy will be presented.

Members of 4-H Clubs participating in the national contest will compete

in the wool judging only. The national 4-H event is held here in conjunction with the 39th Sonora Wool and Mohair Show. The 4-H Club event began here in 1947.

"This is a good opportunity for youth to receive valuable training in the classification, grading and evaluation of wool," said Clint Langford, Sutton County Extension Agent and one of the show planners.
