Week Set
May 22-27
The Postal Service designates a
week during May each year when week during May each year when
customers on rural, city motorized,
and contract delivery mail routes and contract delivery mail routes
are encouraged to examine and improve, where necessary, the
appearance of their mailboxes. appearance of their mailooxes.
The week of May $22-27$ has been
selected this selected this year. The purpose of
Mailbox Improvement Week is to Mailbox Improvement Week is to
call attention to the need for call attention to the need for
providing mail receptacles which
are designed to are designed to protect the mail
from the weather and are neat in from the weather and are neat in
appearance, conveniently located, and safe to use. "Neat, attractive
mailboxes make mailboxes make a significant
contribution to the appearance of the contribution to the appearance of the
countryside and the streets in suburban areas,"
Richard Wilson. Where box numbers are assigned,
Whard
Wral route box nut shown on the side of the box visible o the approaching carrier, or on the
dour where boxes are grouped. If the box is located on the street other than the one on which the customer number must be inscribed on the In all instances, placing the
owner's name on the box is optional owner's name on the box is optional.
Generally, boxes should be installed with the bottom of the box between three and one-half and four feet
from the roadway. However rrom the roadway. However, due to
varying road and curb conditions. varying road and curb conditions,
and other factors, it is recommended that customers con-
tact the postmaster or carrier prior tact the postmaster or carrier prior
to initially erecting or replacing their mailbox and support. On city motorized routes with
curbline delivery, it is recommend-
ed that the box be either ed that the box be either the
approved traditional rural type box or an approved suburban box of
contemporary design. Boxes de. contemporary design. Boxes de-
signed primarily for use by customers receiving door delivery
are difficult to serve efficiently from are difficult to serve efficiently from
a vehicle and their use is not encouraged. However, any box that gives
protection to the mail and allows safe, convenient delivery from the
carriers vehicle is acceptable. Boxers should be installed with
bottom of the box between three and bottom of the box between three and
one--hall and four feet from the me-hway. Where boxes are not
poodwated directly in front of the
loce customer's residence, the house
gumber must be shown on the box. When a maillox is newly installed a an unsuitable receptacle is
replaced on contract delivery replaced on contract delivery
routes, and approved box of either the traditional rural type or
contemporary design must be contemporary design must
installed.
Mailbores on both rural and Mailboxes on both rural and
contract routes must be located on
the right-hand side of the road in the the right-hand side of the road in the
direction traveled by the carrier. direction traveled by he carrier.
The box must be placed and served
to comply with state laws and to comply with state laws and
highway and postal regulations. The
carrier must have access without carrier must have access with
having to leave the vehicle. Supports for mailboxes should be of adequate strength and size to
properly support the box. Reports have been received that some mailoox supports are so massive
that they are damaging the vehicles and causing serious injuries to the peope who accidently strike them.
The use of heavy metal posts,
concrete posts, concrete posts, and miscellaneous
items of farm equipment, such as milk cans filled with concrete, is an assembly which, if struck, will bend or fall away from the striking vehicle instead of severely damag.
