the Lazbuddie Flood Prevention
Dam during a final completion check.
All those attending were extremey impressed by the dam and felt this
would be of great benefit to Parmer County.
Most people in the county do not dam.
Some figures of interest on the structure: The dam contains 411,260 cubic
s of fill. 58 feet 2. Height is 56 feet.
3. The main spilway contains :396 aubic yards of concrete along with
200,000 pounds of reinforcing steel. 4. The water in the dam will cover
63 surface acres and contain 427 63 surface acres and contain 4127 acre feet at draw down stage.
5. There are four emergency pillways with each about 200 feet
