### It Happened in Sanderson TEN YEARS AGO This week—Remember?

December 23, 1932  
H. H. Thomas and M. P.

Brown of El Paso went hunting in the Big Bend country. For two days they tramped through the mountains in search of a buck. They saw several deer, but their shots went astray. Discouraged they camped near Marfa.

"If I saw a buck now, I would try to lasso it," said Thomas. "They down steers at rodeos with out a gun. The art should be extended to include wild game."

About that time a buck darted by the camp. "There's your chance to practice bulldogging," said Brown.

Forgetting his rifle, Thomas took out after his quarry. The deer slowed down, looked around at Thomas, and started to retrace its tracks. Thomas, befuddled, headed back to camp at a Charley Paddock pace.

Before he got very far, the buck over took him and hooked him in the leg.

Later, border patrolmen explained that the deer was a pet, familiar with the ways of man.

On Monday afternoon open house was held at the local office of the Texas Louisiana Power Company, with Clyde Morris. (Continued to page 5)

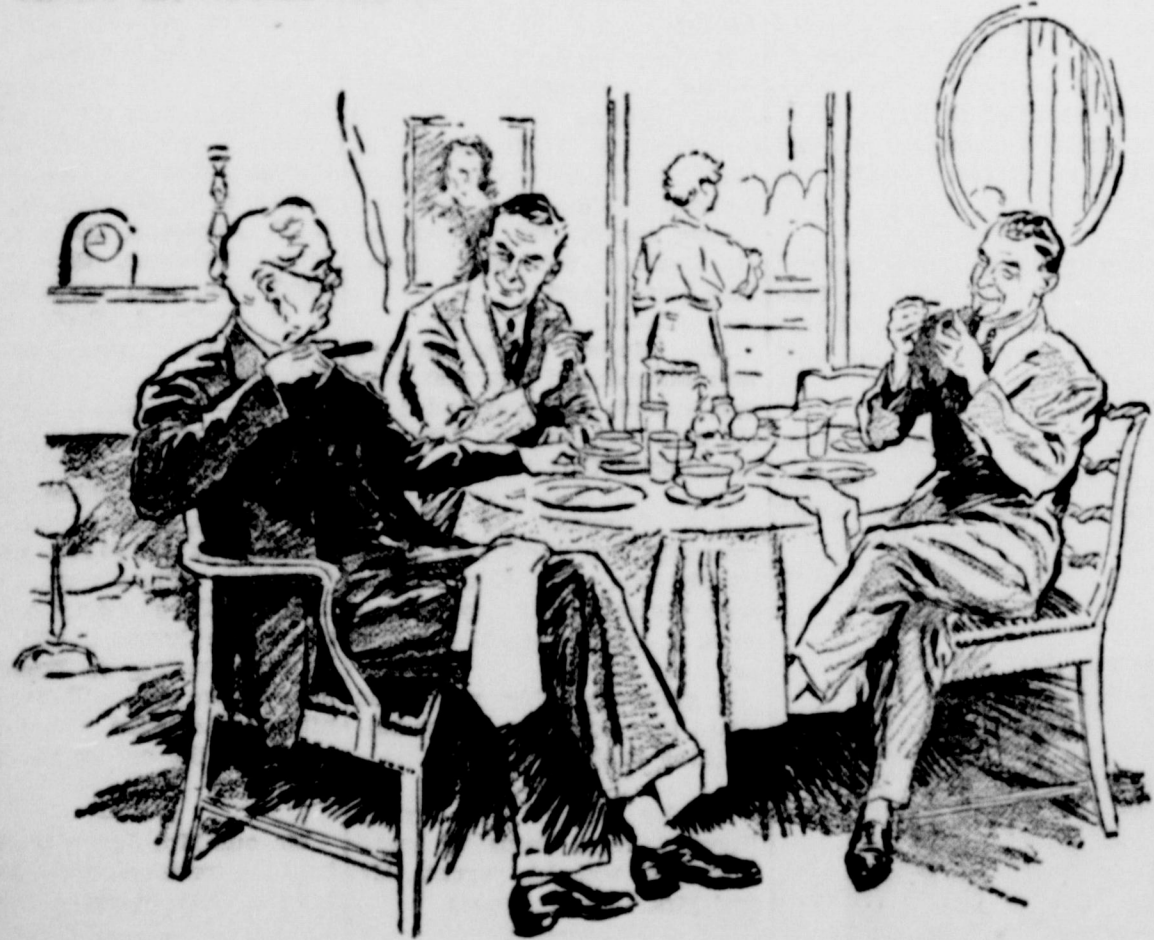
