## Moisture For '99: Cautious Optimism

 Although the total moisture for the month of May in Friona never-the-less should provide at least a confidence boost to The monthThe month of May is traditionally one of the wettest
months of the season, and local farmers, gardeners and yard buffs remember all too well that in 1998, the month "came
and went" without so much as a trace of moisture. May's total edged out January for the most moisture this
calendar year, by a single digit, 2.44 inches to 2.43 The monthly total brought calendar year 1999 's total
moisture to 8.83 . This is a gain of $45 \%$ over the total from last year at the same time, which was 3.93 inches. The month of May, 1999 may have seemed even wetter,
due to the fact that moisture was received on seven consecutive dates, May 24 through the 30 th, and eight days out of nine starting with the 22 nd. Longtime residents
recognize that this was a rare occurrence, as well, even theugh recognize that this was a rare occurrence, as well, even though
the daily moisture ranged only from .03 inches to 42 inches. Here are the monthly totals for calenchar 1999, with the

. Smart seniors know that driving makes extra vision demands on them and see their optometrist regularly for testing. Very often a stronger prescription may make driving safer and less stressful.
Many older drivers also find it helpful to compensate for increasing vision problems by modifying their driving habits: avoiding heavy traffic and night driving, and spending less time on the road.
